YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 4-2, at FNB Field. John Michael Bertrand started for Richmond and threw six scoreless innings before allowing two runs in the seventh. In that frame, Joe Naranjo and Maxwell Romero Jr. each hit RBI singles to give Harrisburg a 2-0 lead. With two outs and runners on second and third in the top of the eighth, Bryce Eldridge hit a three-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead. On the next pitch, Cal Mitchell drove a solo homer to open a 4-2 lead. Trent Harris threw 1.1 scoreless innings. Nick Garcia recorded the final two outs to close his first save of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams played in Harrisburg's first home series at FNB Field from April 9-13, with Richmond taking two-of-six in the series. The Flying Squirrels have been outscored 38-6 in the series but are looking for their second straight series split.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,894 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7.290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS split last week's series against the Patriots, winning three straight games from Thursday through Sunday for their longest win streak of the season. Their 10-22 start is tied for the worst in team history, even with the 2016 season. That team was 10-23 through 33 games.

THE SENATORS have won eight-of-their-last-12 games, including taking four-of-six last week at Reading. Harrisburg lost four straight games to open the season but have gone 16-12 since. The Senators are first in Eastern League in hits (257), first in total bases (425) and rank tied for first in homers (30). Harrisburg's roster includes three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9) and 1B/3B Yohandy Morales (No. 22). Harrisburg's roster also featured three players included in MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and Morales (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his second start of 2025. His previous start this season was also at Harrisburg on April 12, when he surrendered one run over four innings in the second game of a doubleheader. Sinacola posted a 2.45 ERA (4 ER/14.2 IP) over his first four outings of the year but is 0-1 with a 19.29 ERA (10 ER/4.2 IP) in his last three appearances since April 30. In 2024, he went 9-3 with a 3.56 ERA in 25 games (17 starts) between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond. He was promoted to the Eastern League on June 5, 2024 and made 15 Double-A starts, going 5-2 with a 4.08 ERA. After allowing four runs in 4.1 innings in his Double-A debut last June, Sinacola went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) over his next five starts from June 12-July 4. Sinacola was selected in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine. For more on Sinacola, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Hyun-il Choi makes his fourth Eastern League start and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He started the series opener on Tuesday and allowed three hits with six strikeouts over five scoreless innings in a combined shutout. Choi began the season with Triple-A Rochester for his first four outings and went 0-3 with a 17.18 ERA in three starts before throwing a scoreless relief outing on April 20. He was sent to Double-A Harrisburg on April 24 and allowed five runs over six innings the next day against the SeaWolves. Choi originally signed with the Dodgers in 2018 out of Korea. Last December, he was selected in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 Draft by the Nationals.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 19 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 11 runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is fourth in the EL with eight.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit. 291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On Thursday, he tied his Double-A high with three hits. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .298 (14-for-47) in his last 11 games. On Saturday night, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell opened the season batting 189 (14-for-74) in his first 20 games through April 26. In his last 10 games dating back to April 29, Howell is batting .267 (12-for-45) with three homers, two doubles, five RBIs, four walks and six runs scored. After hitting three homers in his first 136 Double-A games, he homered three times over a five-game span from last Wednesday through Sunday. On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week for the first time. Last year, Howell was named Richmond's Player of the Year and led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7) and leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), OBP (.347), SLG (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), runs (64) and stolen bases (15).

GO, DIEGO, GO: Diego Velasquez had his league-leading 13-game hitting streak snapped last Sunday afternoon. In those 13 games from April 18-May 2, Velasquez hit .392 (20-for-51) with a homer, four doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. In his 69 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .305 (79-for-259). His 13-game hit streak was the longest since a 13-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in 2022.

CLOSING THE DOOR: Last Thursday, Tyler Myrick closed the 14th save of his Flying Squirrels career, tying ninth place on the franchise's all-time list with **Brett Bochy** (2012) and **Melvin Adon** (2019, 2022). In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Myrick has converted 82.4 percent of his save attempts, which is tied for fifth-highest in franchise history (min. 15 attempts). In 2023 between Richmond and High-A Eugene, Myrick went 15-for-15 in save attempts, the only pitcher in MiLB with a perfect mark and at least 12 tries.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for sixth in hits (33). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for fifth in homers (5). **Seth Lonsway** is 10th in ERA (2.45), seventh in innings pitched (29.1) and eighth in BAA (.194). **Jack Choate** is tied for 10th in strikeouts (34).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 214 wins in his career, which is two away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

AWARDS SWEEP: On Monday, **Carter Howell** was named Eastern League Player of the Week after homered three times against Somerset and **Joe Whitman** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after throwing six perfect innings on Saturday with 10 strikeouts. It marked the fifth time in franchise history the team has swept the league's weekly awards, joining **Daniel Mayora** and **Justin Fitzgerald** (July 9-16, 2012), **Steven Duggar** and **Andrew Suarez** (July 18-24, 2016), **Brett Auerbach** and **Wil Jensen** (August 1-7, 2022) and **Grant McCray** and **John Michael Bertrand** (May 20-26, 2024).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

1972: The Richmond Braves beat the Charleston Charlies, 7-1, at Parker Field. Shaun Fitzmaurice hit a three-run homer in the first inning to center to open the scoring. Fred Velazquez hit a solo homer in the fourth and added a sacrifice fly in a three-run eighth inning. Jimmy Free-man started and picked up his fourth straight win. Atlanta Braves manager Luman Harris was in attendance for the game. **2014:** The Flying Squirrels swept a Mother's Day double-header against the Erie SeaWolves at The Diamond. In Game 1, Ryan Lollis hit a grand slam and Ty Blach pitched a complete game in a 5-3 win. In Game 2, Matt Duffy hit a solo homer and finished with four RBIs in a 6-3 victory.
