**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped their second-straight game in walk-off fashion, 3-2, to Wilmington on Saturday night...CF **Jacob Young** slapped the game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th...C **Drake Osborn** hammered a 2-run home run for the Cyclones in the 2nd...Blue Rocks tied it on a Young single and throwing error in the 7th...Young went 4-for-4 with 2 doubles and a walk...RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 5.0 shutout innings for Brooklyn in a no-decision...Wilmington RHP **Chance Huff** hurled a career-high 7.0 innings in a no-decision...RHP **Todd Peterson** went 2.0 scoreless and earned the win for the Blue Rocks.

**FEELING BULL-ISH:** Dating back to last Sunday, Brooklyn relief pitchers have permitted just 8 runs (6 earned) over 35.0innings (1.54 ERA)...In that span, Cyclones relievers have surrendered just 23 hits, walked 13, and struck out 39...Entering play on Sunday, Brooklyn holds the 2nd-best bullpen ERA (3.63) in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome's (3.19) relief arms have posted a better earned run average.

**STU-PER DUPER:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 8.0 innings with 5.0 scoreless frames at Wilmington on Saturday...Entering Sunday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.40)...He is also tied for 6th in batting average against (.202)...The right-hander is also 4th in strikeout rate (32.1%) and 5th in xFIP (3.45) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.92).

**NONE SHALL PASS:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 10 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 4 hits and 4 walks, striking out 17 (13.12 K/9)...In 15 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 16.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 23 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 9 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 32 strikeouts in 26.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

**JUMPIN' JOE:** OF/1B **Joe Suozzi** comes in to Sunday's series finale riding a season-high-tying 4-game hitting streak...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 4-for-his-last-13 (.308) with 2 runs scored, a double, 2 RBI, and a walk...Suozzi has registered a .742 OPS in those 4 contests...Dating back to April 26 at Jersey Shore, the 25-year-old has registered at least one base knock in 8-of-10 games.

**NEW MONTH, NEW MAN:** C **Kevin Parada** has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 10 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .297/.366/.568 with a .934 OPS...Parada is 11-for-37 at the dish (.297) with 5 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 5 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .420 wOBA and a 148 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in doubles (5), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (7), and tied for 7th in slugging (.568).

**WIZARD OF OS:** C **Drake Osborn** enters Sunday's fixture on a season-long 6-game on-base streak...Since registering his first multi-hit game as a Cyclone on May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 6-for-21 at the plate (.286) with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...Osborn holds an .967 OPS since the streak began.

**SAY HEY, JAY:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has reached base safely in 9-straight games entering Saturday...Dating back to May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 22-year-old is 7-for-30 at the dish (.233) with a .661 OPS...Palmer has picked up 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, driven in a tally, and walked 6 times...The Canarsie native is also 4-for-5 on stolen base attempts in that span...Palmer is also 7-for-7 on stolen base attempts against Wilmington in 2023 and tied for the team lead with 13.

**ALEX SMACKS:** OF **Alex Ramírez** had his team-season-long 19-game on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, but has reached in 21-of-22 games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .294/.375/.365 with a .740 OPS and a 110 wRC+...Alex is 25-for-85 at the dish with 9 runs scored, 4 extra-base

**vs. WILMINGTON:** Brooklyn heads south for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast 5 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **James Wood** (1), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (8), OF **T.J. White** (10), RHP **Andry Lara** (15), and INF **Trey Lipscomb** (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against Wilmington in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-9 record at Frawley Stadium last year...The Blue Rocks captured 3-of-5 games from the Cyclones at Maimonides Park from April 18-22.

hits, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 9 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (50), hits (91) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (132).

**GEBER FEVER:** RHP **Jordan Geber** has been dominant over his last 3 outings for Brooklyn...Since his first start of the season on April 22 vs. Wilmington, the 23-year-old holds a 1-0 record with a minuscule 0.64 ERA (1 ER in 14.0 IP) over 3 appearances...Geber has permitted only 5 hits and 2 walks, in addition to racking up 13 strikeouts...Since that date, Geber has the 5th-lowest ERA (0.64) in the SAL among pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched...The right-hander's WHIP (0.50) is also the lowest in the circuit during that time frame (min. 10.0 IP).

**'DASH' LOS SANTOS:** In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (90), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (86), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdéz** (86), and Athletics OF **Esteury Ruiz** (85)...De Los Santos has also snagged 48 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 35...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS:** Brooklyn pitching did nothing but post zeroes on the scoreboard in Sunday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...It was the Cyclones' first shutout victory of the season...It was Brooklyn's first shutout win since September 9, 2022, at Winston-Salem...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (7.0 IP) and RHP **Daison Acosta** (2.0) combined on a 3-hit, 3-0 blanking of the Dash...It was the first for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park since August 5, 2022, also against Winston-Salem...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (4.1), RHP **David Griffin** (3.2), and RHP **Dylan Hall** (1.0) united on a 6-hit, 2-0 victory.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (30/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision in his 2023 Cyclones debut on Tuesday night at Wilmington...Yielded 2 runs on 4 hits over a season-high 2.2 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 1...Charged with a balk for a disengagement violation...Threw a season-high 45 pitches (31 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Paul Gervase** with a man at 2nd and 2 out in the bottom of the 3rd and the game at tied at one...Bequeathed runner scored...2B **Kevin Kendall** provided the go-ahead sacrifice fly in the top of the 11th, as the Cyclones bested the Blue Rocks, 5-4.

**BACK IN BROOKLYN:** Scott was transferred back to the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 5.

**2022:** Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on May 10...Collected a 3-3 mark with a 4.82 ERA (20 ER in 37.1 IP) and 52 strikeouts in 12 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Placed on the 7-day injured list on July 3 and reinstated on July 27...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 3.80 ERA (9 ER in 21.1 IP) with 25 K's in 6 outings (5 starts) with the Cyclones...Did not appear for Brooklyn in the postseason.

**FREE 'FALL'-IN:** Following the 2022 Minor League season, Scott was one of several Mets prospect selected to participate in the prestigious Arizona Fall League...The 23-year-old made 4 starts for the Peoria Javelinas, tallying an 0-2 record and a 10.38 ERA (15 ER in 13.0 IP) with 10 strikeouts...Scott was teammates with fellow 2023 Cyclones OF **Stanley Consuegra** and INF **Kevin Kendall**, as well as former Brooklyn standouts OF **Brandon McIlwain** '22, INF **Luke Ritter** '21, and RHP **Grant Hartwig** '22.

**GREAT SCOTT:** Scott entered the 2023 season ranked as one of the New York Mets Top 30 prospects according to various publications...The right-hander is deemed New York's No. 26 farmhand by *Baseball America* and No. 30 by MLB Pipeline.

**BEAM ME UP:** The 23-year-old split his time between the rotation and bullpen in 2022...In 9 starts between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, Scott managed a 1-2 record with a 4.81 ERA (18 ER in 33.2 IP), adding 44 strikeouts (11.76 SO/9)...In 9 games in relief, the Pompano Beach, Fla. native registered a 2-1 mark plus a 3.96 ERA (11 ER in 25.0 IP), snatching 33 K's.
