LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped the opening contest of a six-game set in Aberdeen, falling to the IronBirds by a score of 9-2 to fall to 1-3 in the season's second half...Brooklyn was limited to just three hits in the defeat, going just 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position...3B **Jesús Báez** whacked a double to center field for his first High-A hit...CF **Reed Trimble** notched a three-hit, four RBI night for the IronBirds...RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** gave up three runs, all earned, over 2.2 innings en route to the loss, while RHP **Michael Forret** spun five one-hit shutout innings for Aberdeen, good enough to earn the win...Beyond Báez, CF **Nick Morabito** and LF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** also collected base knocks for Brooklyn.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 26, 2016, SS **José Reyes** signed a minor league contract with the New York Mets and was assigned to Brooklyn...As a 33-year-old, Reyes appeared in four games with Brooklyn, going 2-for-11 (.182) at the plate with a double, an RBI, and two stolen bases...The Santiago, D.R. native appeared in 1,365 games over 12 years with the Mets, hitting .282/.334/.433 with a .768 OPS, 108 home runs, 521 RBI, and 408 stolen bases...On June 26, 2022, the Brooklyn Cyclones bested the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, 2-1, at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn won the contest on a walk-off RBI single from DH **Matt O'Neill** in the bottom of the ninth.

WELCOME TO CONEY ISLAND: INF **Jesús Báez** joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday and went 1-for-4 with a double and a run scored in his High-A debut on Tuesday night...Báez is the No. 15 Prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and will be the first player in franchise history born in 2005...Through 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on Tuesday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite not appearing in a game for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League with 25 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (.382) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (62) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is sixth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (135).

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Sunday's win over Jersey Shore...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in slugging (.493), eighth in OPS (.864), tied for eighth in total bases (108) and extra-base hits (26), and 10th in on-base percentage (.371)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.864) and slugging (.493), tied for third in extra-base hits (26), tied for fourth in home runs (10) and triples (3), fifth in RBI (37), tied for fifth in hits (59) and doubles (13), and sixth in batting average (.269) and total bases (108)...Morabito is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (33) and 11th in on-base percentage (.435)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (22), tied for third in runs scored (29), tied for fourth in hits (46), and 10th in on-base percentage (.382)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.329), on-base percentage (.435), and stolen bases (33)...He also is second in hits (76), third in runs scored (43), and fourth in OPS (.858) and walks (38).

HOME COOKING OR ROAD WARRIOR?: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 27 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .357/.439/.684 with a 1.123 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 13 walks to 15 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.357), on-base percentage (.439), slugging (.684), and OPS (1.123)...In 31 road affairs, Lorusso hits .198/.317/.339 with a .656 OPS, adding four home runs and 19 RBI with 21 walks to 39 K's...OF **Nick Morabito**, on the other hand, has loved his time on the road, hitting .326/.426/.446 with an .872 OPS, adding two home runs, five RBI, and 21 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is second in the circuit in road hits (30) and runs scored (21), while swiping nine more bases (21) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .250/.314/.281 line with a .595 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 15 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .300/.357/.420 mark with a .777 OPS, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 28 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .160/.270/.234 with a .504 OPS, a home run, and six runs batted in over 27 contests.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 26 of 27 games, hitting .250/.402/.391 with a .793 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 22 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 23 walks...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in walks (23) and ninth in on-base percentage (.402)...The third-year pro has also reached in 15-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .256/.418/.451 with a .869 OPS in that span, accumulating 12 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 15 walks to 16 strikeouts.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilen** saw his 26-game on-base streak come to an end in last Saturday's loss to Jersey Shore...The streak is tied for the third-longest of the year in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome's INF **Sabin Ceballos** (27) and Greenville's INF **Kristian Campbell** (34) put together longer streaks...The 21-year-old accumulated a .268/.357/.402 slash line with a .759 OPS during the streak, adding five doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks...The

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series of the season's second half against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen boasts five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), and C **Creed Willems** (29)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in the first meeting (April 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent rendezvous (June 4-9)...Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 12 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...In 251 meetings dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 133-119 (.528)

infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilen also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 49 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.5% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 250 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits third in walk rate...Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF **Ryan Clifford** leads Minor League Baseball (22.2%).

OH, HENRY!: The Cyclones added RHP **Henry Henry** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect **Henry Henry** or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee **King Henry**.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 62 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.48 ERA (28 ER in 101.2 IP) and 7 saves, walking just 25 and striking out 91.

SO LONG, STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday...Consuegra departs Brooklyn as the franchise's all-time leader in numerous offensive categories...Last Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (209)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (186) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI. Consuegra ended his time in Brooklyn with a bang, hitting .282/.389/.518 with a .907 OPS since May 17...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had scored 16 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...In that time, Consuegra was tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for eighth in total bases (57), and ninth in slugging (.518).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win at the High-A level last Thursday night vs. Jersey Shore...Did not allow a run on one hit over 5.0 innings...Walked three and struck out seven...Tossed 85 pitches and 53 strikes (62.35%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the top of the sixth inning with the Cyclones leading 2-0...Brooklyn held on to defeat the BlueClaws, 2-1.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

THE TONG SONG: The 20-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In 13 appearances (11 starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 3-1 with a 2.44 ERA (15 ER in 55.1 IP)...Among full-season Minor League pitchers with 50.0+ innings pitched, Tong is sixth in FIP (2.36) and eighth in strikeout rate (34.8%).

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zach Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
