**LAST OUTING:** Rodriguez allowed a season-high eight hits against Memphis on July 5. It was his first start and second appearance since returning to Nashville. He allowed five earned runs across five innings in a 7-4 loss.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Rodriguez's first career appearance against Iowa.
