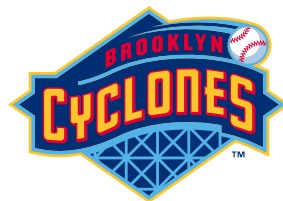

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn rallied from 3 runs down to defeat Greenville, 5-4, on Sunday afternoon at Maimonides Park...2B **César Berbesi** powered a 2-run home run in the 7th to pull the Cyclones within 1...SS **William Lugo** delivered a go-ahead 2-run blast in the 8th to give Brooklyn the lead for good...RHP **Wilkin Ramos** faced the minimum over 3.0 shutout frames of relief to earn his 3rd win...RHP **Blade Tidwell** tied a career-high with 10 strikeouts for Brooklyn over 4.0 innings...Greenville's RHP **Angel Bastardo** hurled 6.0 frames of 1-run ball...C **Kevin Parada** tied a career-high with 3 hits, while 3B **Mateo Gil** and Berbesi added multi-hit games...LF **Miguel Ugueto** accrued 3 hits, 2 doubles, and an RBI for the Drive.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdley Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

PARADA DAY: C **Kevin Parada** tied a career and season best with 3 hits in Sunday's win vs. Greenville...Since May 27 vs. Winston-Salem, the 2022 No. 11 pick is slashing .321/.367/.429 with a .795 OPS and 121 wRC+...Parada is 18-for-56 at the plate with 4 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, and 4 walks...Since that date, Parada is tied for the SAL lead in hits (18) and 6th in batting average (.321)...Entering Tuesday, the former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket is tied for 5th in the circuit in doubles (14) for the season.

CYCLONE SHUFFLE: The Cyclones made a series of roster moves on Monday...RHP **Christian Scott** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while LHP **Quinn Brodey** returned to Brooklyn from Binghamton...OF **Scott Ota** was reinstated from the 7-day injured list and OF **Dyron Campos** was transferred back to the Florida Complex League Mets...In 6 starts for Brooklyn, Scott tallied a 1-0 record with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER in 23.2 IP) and 27 strikeouts to just 4 walks...Brodey held a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) and 23 punch outs in 11 relief appearances during his first stint for the 'Clones...Ota was 0-for-3 in 1 game before landing on the IL on June 1...Campos also went 0-for-3 playing in Game 2 on Saturday vs. Greenville.

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 25 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 59 earned runs (83 total) on 165 hits through the last 211.0 innings...That is good for a 2.52 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the 3rd-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Only Kansas City's Single-A Columbia (2.43) and Washington's Single-A Fredericksburg (2.48) have lower marks...Cyclones' pitching has walked 96 (10.8 BB%) and struck out 258 in that span (29.1 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 103-83, over the 25-game stretch...Brooklyn is 13-12 during that span.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.20) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.33) is 2nd in the circuit and the Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.27) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 4th best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (2.97).

GOING, GOING, GIL: INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 18 of his last 20 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .273/.360/.546 and he has registered an impressive .906 OPS, 143 wRC+, 404 wOBA, and .273 ISO in that time...Gil is 18-for-66 at the plate (.273) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 3rd in the league in home runs (4), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (10) and slugging (.546), tied for 6th in doubles (6), and RBI (13), and tied for 7th in OPS (.906).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 5 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP) with just 10 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 20 and struck out 33 (14.61 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 36.7% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .143 batting average (10-70) against him.

TY-NAMIC: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 9 in Game 2 on Saturday and has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.47)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (86.8%) and FIP (2.67), 4th in xFIP (3.27), and 7th in strikeout rate (30.5%), and strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20).

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road to begin a 6-game road trip against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds posses 7 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS **Jackson Holliday** (1), OF **Jud Fabian** (13), 3B **Max Wagner** (14), OF **Dylan Beavers** (19), C **Creed Willems** (21), RHP **Trace Bright** (27), and RHP **Jean Pinto** (28)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium for the first time since the 2022 SAL Postseason...Aberdeen won both postseason contests at home to defeat Brooklyn, 2-1, in a Best-of-3 series from September 13-16...In 2023, the IronBirds and Cyclones have split the first 6 games of the season series...Both teams won 3 contests in their matchup at Maimonides Park from May 2-7.

JEFF JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** suffered the loss in Game 1 on Saturday, but permitted just 1 earned run over 5.1 innings...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 4 appearances (3 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER in 18.2 IP), allowing 14 hits and 8 walks, striking out 21...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 7 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 4 walks over 11.1 innings, registering 19 strikeouts (15.1 K/9)...That equates to a 45.2 K% (19/42).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville...The 23-year-old did not allow a hit and walked 1 hitter, tossing 40 pitches and a season-high 28 strikes...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.46)...Only Rome's RHP **Luis Vargas** (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.14 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 32.7% strikeout rate.

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th last Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign... 19.6% (11-of-56) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After dropping Saturday's twinbill to Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 23-23 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (99), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (98), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), Mariners prospect OF **Jonathan Clásé** (95), and Royals prospect OF **Dairon Blanco** (92) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 39... Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Tuesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (190), at-bats (626), plate appearances (748), runs scored (96), walks (102), and stolen bases (46)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (66) on May 23 and is 3 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (193), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 5th in hits (115).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Despite Maimonides Park’s pitcher-friendly tendencies, Foster has faired slightly better away from Coney Island in 2023...The 24-year-old holds an 1-2 mark, but a 4.44 ERA (13 ER in 26.1 IP) with 10 walks and 25 strikeouts in 5 road starts...At home, Foster is 1-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP), 9 walks, and 15 strikeouts.
