LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped a nail-biter to the Blue Rocks on Wednesday night, 5-3...Brooklyn captured their three runs on a missed catch error, a wild pitch, and a run-producing ground out from SS **Kevin Kendall**...Wilmington jumped ahead for good with a 4-run top of the 8th...1B **T.J. White** slapped an RBI single, C **Wilmer Pérez** and SS **Jordy Barley** coaxed run-scoring walks, and LF **Jacob Young** capped the frame with a sacrifice fly...RHP **Joander Suárez** posted 5.0 frames of 1-run ball in a no-decision for the 'Clones...LHP **Andrew Alvarez** punched out 9 in 4.2 frames for the Rocks.

DANG, DANIEL!: LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 4 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 8...In 9 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 9.1 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 17-straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 23 strikeouts in 19.2 innings.

RED HOT RAMÍREZ: OF **Alex Ramírez** comes into Thursday riding a season-high 6-game hitting streak...That is tied with OF **Omar De Los Santos** for the longest hitting streak by a Cyclone in 2023...The 20-year-old is 9-for-his-last-24 (.375) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases...Since joining Brooklyn last July 4, Ramírez leads all SAL hitters in hits (75) and extra-base hits (27)...He is also 2nd in total bases (115) and tied for 2nd in RBI (41).

KENDALL KEEPING ON: INF **Kevin Kendall** has reached base safely in 10-straight games to start his Brooklyn career...After being limited to just 3 games last year due to injury, the former UCLA Bruin is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in triples (2)...Entering play on Thursday, Kendall is tied for 2nd on the Cyclones in walks (9), and 4th in total bases (14) plus on-base percentage (.360).

CONSUE-HEY!: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week (April 10-16) on Monday...During last week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI last Thursday...The Dominican native's previous 4-hit night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into Wednesday, Consuegra is tied for 2nd in the SAL lead in home runs (3) and extra-base hits (6)...He is also tied for 3rd in total bases (24) and doubles (3), and tied for 4th in RBI (10).

KING CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 6 games in 2023...Berbesi is 8-for-21 (.381) at the plate with 7 runs scored, a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Thursday's game 2nd in the SAL in on-base percentage (.567)...He is also 7th in batting average (.381) and 10th in OPS (1.043)...Berbesi

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 5 of the Nats' top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **James Wood** (1), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (8), OF **T.J. White** (10), RHP **Andry Lara** (15), and INF **Trey Lipscomb** (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against the Blue Rocks in 2022...Brooklyn and Wilmington split 10 games at Maimonides Park last season...The Cyclones are 14-9 all-time at home vs. Wilmington.

has walked 74 times compared to only 83 strikeouts in 102 career games.

GRAB SOME PINE: Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches last Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory...RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodriguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The 17 strikeouts are tied for the most by a pitching staff in a South Atlantic League game this year...Aberdeen and Greenville also struck out 17 on April 8 and 15, respectively.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-100 (.519).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his last start at Winston-Salem on Thursday...Yielded 2 runs on 2 hits over a season-high 3.0 innings...Tied a career-high with 3 walks allowed and set a new-career best with 7 strikeouts...Yielded a 2-run home run to LF **Ben Norman** in the 2nd...Threw 61 pitches (31 strikes)...Relieved by LHP **Daniel Juárez** to start the bottom of the 4th and Brooklyn leading, 8-2...Cyclones went on to defeat the Dash, 8-3.

2022: Gómez served primarily as a relief pitcher for the eventual Florida State League champion St. Lucie Mets...Joined the club from extended spring training on May 2...Accrued a 4-5 record with 3 saves and a 3.78 ERA (20 ER in 47.2 IP) in 24 appearances (2 starts)...Entered twice in relief during the postseason...Earned a win and did not allow a run or hit, striking out 5, over 5.1 innings.

TRIPLE DIGITS: In his last start on Thursday at Winston-Salem, Gómez tossed 40 pitches in excess of 96 mph...6 of his 61 pitches o were 100+ mph...Gómez topped at 101.0 mph in the matchup against the Dash...Gómez’s fastball topped out 100.2 mph on two separate ocassions in 2022 with Single-A St. Lucie on August 4 vs. Daytona.

START ME UP: Gómez is expected to make his 7th career start on Thursday...In his first 6 between the Dominican Summer League, Single-A St. Lucie, and Brooklyn, the 21-year-old has an 0-1 mark with a 5.56 ERA (7 ER in 11.1 IP), 8 walks, and 12 strikeouts...Prior to Opening Day, took the loss in his previous start on August 10, 2022, at Clearwater (2.2 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

TEAM LEADER: With Single-A St. Lucie, Gómez led all pitchers on the staff (min. 40.0 IP) in home runs-per-nine-innings (0.19)...Additionally, the Venezuela native ranked second in walk percentage (9.8%) and FIP (3.04).
