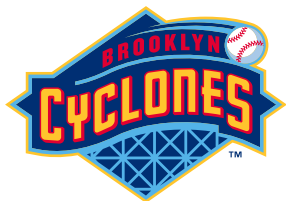

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn suffered a 5-4 loss in 11 innings on Friday night at Jersey Shore...BlueClaws won it on 2B **Freylin Minyety**'s walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th...Brooklyn took a 2-1 lead in the 4th on 2B **Mateo Gil**'s solo home run...Jersey Shore scored 3 times in the 7th to take a 4-2 lead...Cyclones tied it in the 8th on a double play ground ball and a Gil single...Gil picked up 2 hits and RBI...RF **Omar De Los Santos** and SS **César Berbesi** each registered multi-hit games, while LF **Eduardo Salazar** garnered 2 knocks, including an RBI double...RF **Leandro Pineda** tallied 2 hits and an RBI for the 'Claws...CF **Cristian Pache** went 0-for-3 with a run scored and a stolen base and C **Rafael Marchán** was 1-for-4 with an RBI in Major League rehab games for Jersey Shore.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Cyclones will play in their 4th doubleheader of the 2023 season on Saturday...Brooklyn has been swept in 2 of their first 3 twinbills of the year...The Cyclones were swept in their initial twinbill on May 10 at Wilmington...Cyclones dropped the opener, 7-4, and the nightcap, 7-1...Brooklyn served as the home team in Game 2...The 'Clones was swept again on Wednesday at Jersey Shore...They fell in the lid-lifter, 9-3, and were shutout in the nightcap, 5-0...Brooklyn split a double-dip on May 21 at Hudson Valley...Brooklyn tossed a shutout in the opener, 6-0, and lost the nightcap in 9 innings, 3-2...In 2022, the Cyclones played in 10 twinbills, registering a split record of 10-10.

BIG STU: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old had his score-less inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings on Sunday, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.13) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP **Dustin Saenz** (2.03)...Stuart is also 8th in the circuit in WHIP (1.15) and 9th in batting average against (.213)...The Kankakee, Ill. native is also 1st in LOB% (89.4%), 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.48), and 4th in strikeout rate (30.8%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

MATEO MASH: INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .256/.370/.615 and he has registered an impressive .985 OPS in that time...Gil is 10-for-39 at the plate (.256) with 8 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 home runs, and 11 RBI adding 7 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (4) with Asheville's OF **Ryan Clifford**...The former 3rd-round pick is also tied for 2nd in the league in RBI (11), 3rd in slugging (.615), and 6th in OPS (.985).

UP TO PAR-ADA: C **Kevin Parada** extended his hitting streak to 7 games with a knock in Friday's loss...The 21-year-old is 9-for-his-last-28 (.321) with a run scored, 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and a pair of walks...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (13)...In May, Parada was tied for 3rd in the circuit in two-baggers (9) and tied for 4th in the league in extra-base hits (12).

OMAR ON THE RUN: OF **Omar De Los Santos** has reached base safely in 6-straight games since Sunday vs. Winston-Salem...The 23-year-old is 8-for-his-last-25 (.333) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, and 3 stolen bases...Since the start of last week's homestand, De Los Santos leads Brooklyn in hits (12), total bases (22), doubles (4), RBI (8), and stolen bases (5)...In addition to his 19 stolen bases in 2023, he remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 89 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (96), and Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (94) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 38...Omar is already 13 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 20 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .300/.380/.529 with a .908 OPS...Estep has accumulated 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 12 RBI in 79 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 144 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 157 points in that time (.047 to .204).

THEY'RE NO. 1: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 15 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 32 earned runs (42 total) on 102 hits through the last 138.0 innings...That is good for a 2.09 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia is 2nd in MiLB (2.32)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 58 (10.2 BB%) and struck out 167 in that span (29.5 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 71-42, over the 16-game stretch...Brooklyn is 10-6 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.83).

BULL-PEN ON PARADE: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.15) in the en-

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs **Orion Kerker** (25) and RHP **Tommy McCollum** (29) are featured...INF **Hao Yu Lee** (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30...The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

tire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Rome (3.55) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.38) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 3rd best in all of MiLB...Texas' Single-A Down East leads MiLB (3.09).

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** tossed another gem on Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts last Friday vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 5 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed a run on 1 hit and walked only 3 over 7.1 innings, registering 10 strikeouts...That equates to a 38.5 K%.

AT HIS BECK-ON CALL: RHP **Jace Beck** has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strike-out rate of 45.1% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is 4th in strikeout rate (45.1%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is 2nd-best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cleveland's RHP **Tyler Thornton** (20.54) leads at High-A Lake County.

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occurred in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP **Keyshawn Aske**w (6.0 IP) and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that day.

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball...Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him.

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (181), at-bats (596), plate appearances (714), runs scored (94), walks (98), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, added an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (189), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (111).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C **Kevin Parada** and CF **Alex Ramírez**...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include **Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), **Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (24/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

SCORELESS STUART: Tyler has posted Brooklyn's longest scoreless inning streak of the season, hurling 15.1-consecutive frames without permitting a run...The stretch lasted from May 2 vs. Aberdeen until May 28 vs. Winston-Salem.

BIG STU: The 6-foot-9 right-hander enters Saturday's doubleheader leading the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.15) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP **Dustin Saenz** (2.03)...Stuart is also 4th in the circuit in OPS against (.579), 8th in WHIP (1.15) and 9th in batting average against (.213)...He is also 4th in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

2022: Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

NEW ROLE: Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 10th professional start on Saturday...In those outings, he is 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (6 ER in 41.1 IP), adding 53 strikeouts (11.54 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

SOARING EAGLE: Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

ALWAYS MOVING: Colina has already pitched at 3 separate levels in 2023...The 22-year-old was assigned to Single-A St. Lucie to start the season...After making 1 appearance, Colina was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on April 16...Earned the win in his lone outing for the Rumble Ponies on April 18...He was transferred to Brooklyn on April 24.

2022: Split the season between St. Lucie and the Florida Complex League...Assigned to St. Lucie on May 2...Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K's in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).

STARTING TIME: Colina expects to make his 1st start of the 2023 season in Game 2 on Saturday after pitching in relief during his initial 7 appearances...Last season, the 22-year-old started in 8 of his 14 outings...In a starting role in 2022, Colina held a 1-3 record with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) in 8 starts...He held a walk rate of 7.3% and a strikeout rate of 28.7%...In 4 relief appearances, the Punto Fijo, VZ native was 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP)...Colina's walk rate was 12.7% and strikeout rate hovered at 28.2%.
