YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels and Rumble Ponies were suspended for rain after five innings with the score tied, 2-2. Binghamton took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning on a two-run single by Alex Ramirez. The unearned runs were the only runs against Richmond starter Joe Whitman, who set a career high with 11 strikeouts in his five innings of work. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 2-2, with a two-run double by Thomas Gavello in the top of the fourth inning. Play was halted after Whitman stranded two runners on base in the bottom of the fifth with his 11th strikeout of the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels compete the second and play the third of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The week is Richmond's first series in Binghamton since May 23-28, 2023, when the Rumble Ponies took five-of-six. The Rumble Ponies come to The Diamond to face the Flying Squirrels in a six-game series from June 10-15. This week's series is Richmond's second against the Northeast Division. They split a six-game series with Somerset from April 29-May 4.

CAUGHT IN SUSPENSION: Wednesday's rain-suspended game was the first for the Flying Squirrels since August 20, 2019. In that game, the Flying Squirrels were playing against the Erie SeaWolves at The Diamond. That game was stopped in the top of the eighth inning with the score tied, 1-1. When play resumed the following day, Erie scored six runs in the top of the 10th inning and held off a Richmond rally in the bottom of the frame for a 7-3 win. The two teams played the night's regularly-scheduled game after and went to extra innings tied, 7-7. Each team scored single runs in the 10th, 11th and 12th. Tied 10-10 entering the 13th, catcher Matt Winn threw a scoreless top of the inning, his third inning of work without allowing an earned run. Winn pitched in both games that night. In the bottom of the 13th, Peter Maris drove a walk-off single to lift the Flying Squirrels to an 11-10 win. Play began that night at 5 p.m. and finished at 11:08 p.m. with 16 innings of baseball. After the games, the Flying Squirrels boarded the buses for an eight-hour trip to Akron, Ohio to begin a series the next night. They lost that game, 5-4, in 10 innings. It was part of a stretch where the Flying Squirrels played five consecutive extra-innings games, beginning the span with a walk-off grand slam by Jacob Heyward on August 19, 2019, through August 23, another 10-inning loss in Akron. They also played six extra-innings games in a seven-game stretch from August 17, 2019.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,022 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the SeaWolves. The Richmond offense ranks fifth in hits (281), eighth in batting average (.223) and has the second-fewest strikeouts (318) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (124). The Richmond pitching staff is last in ERA (5.01).

THE RUMBLE PONIES are in first place in the Northeast Division, a half-game ahead of Portland and have won five-of-their-last-six games since May 14 (G2). Binghamton's roster features seven players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including SS Jett Williams (No. 1), 1B/OF Ryan Clifford (No. 6), OF Nick Morabito (No. 12), RHP Jonath Tong (No. 13), C Kevin Parada (No. 27), RHP Jonathan Pintaro (No. 29) and 1B JT Schwartz (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects lists features six Binghamton players, including Williams (No. 1), Clifford (No. 4), Tong (No. 6), Morabito (No. 17), Pintaro (No. 23) and RHP Jack Wenninger (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his ninth start of the season and the second of his career against FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his ninth start of the season and the second of his career against the Rumble Ponies. Last time out, Bertrand worked a season-high seven innings and allowed one run last Friday against the SeaWolves to pick up his first win of the year. In his last three starts since May 4, Bertrand has a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP). He has made one start against Binghamton, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing three runs in a loss at The Diamond on July 24, 2024. Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels Pitcher to the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two. FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Joander Suarez makes his fifth Double-A start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. His last outing was on Saturday with Triple-A Syracuse against Lehigh Valley and he picked up a win, throwing 5.2 innings with two unearned runs allowed. His last start for Binghamton was on May 11 against Reading and he was charged with a loss after surrendering his first two Double-A runs of the season over 5.1 innings. Suarez pitched 14 scoreless innings in April over two starts and one relief outing before being sent to Triple-A Syracuse for a start on May 1, when he allowed eight runs over three innings. Suarez threw a no-hitter in Hartford in September 2023 in the first game of a doubleheader.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 21 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is second in the Eastern League with 12 runners caught stealing. Morgan is fourth in the EL with nine.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit. 291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .307 (23-for-75) in his last 20 games since April 27. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. He hit his third homer of the year last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the SeaWolves. On Friday, he went 3-for-4 with two homers, a double and four RBIs. In his last seven games since May 13, Eldridge is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with three homers, three doubles and six RBIs.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in all five Double-A games he has played, including three doubles. He has played one game at shortstop and four games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for seventh in hits (39). **Seth Lonsway** is fourth in ERA (2.40), tied for fourth in innings pitched (41.1) and 10th in BAA (.212). **Jack Choate** is eighth in strikeouts (41). **John Michael Bertrand** is eighth in innings pitched (39.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 216 wins in his career, which is for the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 22 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1962: The Richmond Virginians beat the Columbus Jets, 4-3, in 10 innings. Bob Hale drove in the winning run in the bottom of the 10th inning with a two-out single. The Vees trailed, 3-1, in the eighth inning until a two-tying, two-run homer by a Don Brummer. 1972: The Richmond Braves beat the Peninsula Whips, 5-0. Mike Beard, a 21-year-old lefty, threw a complete-game shutout and allowed seven hits, all singles. Fred Velazquez helped open a lead in the third with a two-run single. The Whips were in their first season of two years based out of Hampton's War Memorial Stadium, which put three of the International League's eight teams in Virginia, along with Richmond and Tidewater. They were the original Buffalo Bisons, founded in 1886. The Montreal Expos purchased the team in 1969 and moved them to Winnipeg for the 1970 and 1971 seasons before two years in Hampton. The franchise then moved to Memphis (1974-76), Charleston WVa., (1977-1983) and Old Orchard Beach, Maine (1984-1988) before settling in Moosic, Pa. as the team now called the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. 1982: The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 2-1, at Parker Field. With the score tied, 1-1, in the bottom of the ninth, Matt Sinarto hit a game-winning single over a drawn-in infield through a heavy rain. Tony Brizzolars starter for Richmond and allowed one run, an unearned run in the first. The R-Braves tied the score with an RBI double by Jerry Keller in the first run in the first inning with a sacrifice fly Joavid Justice plated runs with a groundout in the third and a sacrifice fly in the fifth. After the game, Justice was called up to Atlanta to replace injured Lonnie Smith and made his MLB debut two days later. Drew Denson hit an RBI double in the sixth to open a 4-0 lead. Marty Clary started and threw seven scoreless innings. 2016: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 6-5. Trailing, 4-0, in the seventh, Hunter Cole started a rally with a two-run homer. Richmond took the lead with four
