Today's Game: The Sounds begin a 12-game road trip this morning against the Durham Bulls. Nashville won both of the final two games against the Tides to end the series. Durham split a six-game series at Gwinnett last week. Left-handers Aaron Ashby and Mason Montgomery will face off in the series opener at Durham Bulls Athletic Park.

Aaron Ashby: The 25-year-old makes his sixth start of the season and 20th in his career with Nashville. The left hander from Missouri is 0-2 with an 8.68 ERA (18.2 IP/18 ER) this season. He worked his best start of the season last Wednesday (May 1) vs. Norfolk. Though he still had trouble finding the zone at times with four walks, Ashby fired five one-run innings with a season-high six strikeouts. Ashby is facing the Durham Bulls for the first time in his career - it's also his first start against the Rays organization in his career. He has yet to find any success on the road with Nashville this season, going 0-2 with a 21.94 ERA (5.1 IP/13 ER) in two starts. The southpaw was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder Junior College.

Mason Montgomery: The 27-year-old makes his seventh start of the campaign for the Bulls today. The left-hander is 0-5 with an 8.28 ERA (25.0 IP/23 ER). Montgomery last pitched in game one of the doubleheader on May 1 at Gwinnett. He allowed four runs (4 ER) on nine hits in five innings in the loss. He has not taken a loss on April 23 vs. Scranton/WB - the rest of his starts, he has been the losing pitcher. Montgomery is the only pitcher in the International League with five losses entering the day. Last season, he combined to go 7-4 with a 3.98 ERA in 29 games (all starts) between Double-A Montgomery (25) and Durham (4). Montgomery was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech University by the Rays.

Hit Bull, Win Steak: The Bulls are off to a slow start to the season and are at 13-20, 10.5 games behind first place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the International League standings. However, this is not the first time the Bulls have had a slow start to the season. Durham had a 13-20 mark through the first 33 games of the 2022 season before going on a tear and winning the IL East Division, where they would eventually win the Triple-A Championship. The Bulls have won the IL eight times in their history.

A Fine Brew: Outfielder Brewer Hicklen launched a two-out, two-run homer in the eighth inning to provide a little insurance in Nashville's 6-3 win over Norfolk on Sunday afternoon. The offseason acquisition by Milwaukee has reached base in 27 of 30 games this season and 12 of his last 13. He currently ranks tied for second in the league with 14 stolen bases and tied for eighth with 23 runs scored. The Huntsville, Alabama native is batting .305 (32-for-105) with 14 extra-base hits and 17 RBI on the season.

Paredes Putting Them Away: Reliever Enoli Paredes worked a 1-2-3 ninth inning, earning his third save of the season. The right-hander has worked 12 scoreless outings this season, with his only runs allowed coming on April 17 vs. Omaha (2 ER). Paredes boasts a 0.87 WHIP, .154 opponent batting average and a 13.80 K/9 ratio.

Uribe Throwing Gas: Reliever Abner Uribe worked a scoreless eighth inning in his first action after being optioned from Milwaukee. Uribe threw two pitches over 100 MPH per Baseball Savant, including the fastest pitch at the Triple-A level on the day at 101.6 MPH. Only 11 Triple-A pitchers have touched at least 100 multiple times this season - Pirates prospect Paul Skenes leads the level with 98 pitches over the triple digit mark.

Moving On Up: Right-hander Kevin Herget had his contract selected by Milwaukee a second time this season yesterday prior to their game at Kansas City. He had his contract selected prior to a series at Cincinnati on April 9 but did not pitch for the Brewers - he was designated for assignment on April 14 and outrighted back to Nashville on April 18. Herget is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (13.0 IP/5 ER) in 10 outings with the Sounds this season. He also pitched for Triple-A Durham in the 2021 season, going 8-1 with a 2.95 ERA in 21 games (17 starts).

Piling Up the Ks: Sounds pitchers struck out 18 on Saturday night, the highest single-game strikeout total of the season. They are the fourth team in Triple-A and the third in the league to strikeout 18 batters in a game this season (Sacramento on 5/4 vs. Tacoma, Buffalo on April 30 at Indianapolis [10.0 IP] and Columbus on 4/3 vs. Omaha). Nashville had a 19-strikeout game last season vs. Gwinnett on May 11 - that was the last time the Sounds had at least 18 in a game. The Sounds led the league with 75 strikeouts last week - that total was also matched by Sacramento in the Pacific Coast League.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 698-601 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,290-2,121 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
