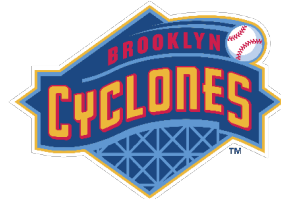

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn split a single-admission doubleheader with the Wilmington Blue Rocks Wednesday, winning 4-2 before falling 9-5 in the nightcap. INF **Shervyen Newton** pounded a three-run home run into the bullpen in right field in game one, turning around an early 1-0 deficit to give the Cyclones a 3-1 lead and eventual 4-2 win. In game two, the Cyclones fought but could not catch up to Wilmington who broke a 5-5 with three runs in the top of the sixth to run away with a 9-5 victory.

THANKS, FOG!: This week, the Cyclones and Blue Rocks are playing eight games in six days, playing a doubleheader on Wednesday and Saturday thanks to two fogged out games at Maimonides Park during the week of May 10-15. Since 2001, the Cyclones have dealt with fog outs but never in a three-day span that was experienced Thursday, Friday, and Saturday in Coney Island. In that series, Wilmington won three of the four games played, winning Tuesday, twice on Sunday, and losing Wednesday.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends next Thursday, June 23 during the six-game series with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. Aberdeen clinched the first half division title on Wednesday night, beating Jersey Shore. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a play-off berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

BMAC ATTACK: OF **Brandon McIlwain** has been on base in 20 of his past 22 games. Since April 30th, McIlwain is hitting .330 with a .427 OBP in 34 games. McIlwain currently ranks first on the team with a 136 wRC+ and has already set a new career-high with 12 stolen bases. His .387 on-base percentage leads all qualified Mets Minor Leaguers and he has six triples which also leads the league.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Frawley Stadium for the first time since the opening weekend of the season. In the season series, Wilmington has won seven of the 10 games. The Blue Rocks host five of Washington's Top 30 prospects, including No. 11 OF Yasel Antuna, No. 15 LHP Mitchell Parker, No. 24 C Israel Pineda, No. 25 OF Ricardo Mendez, and No. 27 INF Jordy Barley.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State returns to the lineup today for the first time since playing in both games of a doubleheader against Aberdeen last Wednesday, June 8th. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 70 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization.

PEROZA PEAKING: With hits in seven of his past 10 games, INF **Jose Peroza** has increased his batting average up 26 points (.195 to .221) and his on-base percentage (.288 to .303) 15 points. In his past five games, the Venezuelan is 7-for-19 with two walks, a triple, and five RBIs.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the team's top prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game Sunday against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs which game during his second professional season in 2019, playing with Rookie-level Kingsport.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 22 home runs in the past 24 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

'CLONES ON THE RISE: OF **Jake Mangum** and INF **Luke Ritter**, two Cyclones from both the 2019 and 2021 clubs, are now with Triple-A Syracuse.

THE HIGH-A DEBUT CONTINUES: Mike Vasil makes his fourth start with Brooklyn and first against Wilmington.

TOP 30: Vasil ranks as the No. 21 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

FLORIDA PHENOM: Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

TAMP DOWN: In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

VASIL AT VIRGINIA: The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

MASSACHUSETTS MIKE: The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
