ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Despite a 1-0 lead in the top of the third inning, the Brooklyn Cyclones dropped a 7-1 decision to Wilmington, allowing the Blue Rocks seven straight runs to even the series at two games apiece. RHP **Junior Santos** allowed a career-high 10 hits over five innings. Down 3-1, Santos surrendered a two-run home run to Washington's No. 14 prospect INF **Yasel Antuna**. Blue Rocks starter LHP **Dustin Saenz**, the No. 25 prospect, tossed six innings of one-run ball in the triumph.

DEBUT DAY: Mets No. 25 prospect RHP **Christian Scott** makes his Brooklyn Cyclones High-A debut today after his promotion from Low-A St. Lucie roster on Monday ahead of the Delaware trip.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 26 games remaining and five series: two more at Wilmington, six vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game head of Hudson Valley for first place.

FEELING BLUE: Brooklyn has won just eight of 19 games against Wilmington this season with a run differential of -21. The Cyclones have only fared worse against Aberdeen (5-13) this season but in those games, Brooklyn has been outscored by 15.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks first in the North Division with a +20 run differential head of Hudson Valley's +12. The Cyclones have allowed just 149 runs over 40 games (3.7 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 414 runs in 106 games (3.9 runs/game) which

vs. WILMINGTON: The Washington Nationals affiliate now hosts the organization's No. 1 prospect OF Robert Hassell III after the OF Juan Soto and INF Josh Bell deal between Washington and San Diego. The Blue Rocks are also home to seven other Top 30 prospects: No. 10 RHP Gerardo Carrillo, No. 14 INF Yasel Antuna, No. 16 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 18 LHP Mitchell Parker, No. 22 C Drew Millas, and No. 25 LHP Dustin Saenz.

ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and sixth-worst in Minor League Baseball in fewest runs.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .820 over his past 25 games with a 13-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 24 of the past 26 games, hitting .277 with a .375 OBP.

RA-RA RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** is ranks second behind Triple-A INF **Brett Baty** with 108 hits -- three behind Baty's 111. The 19-year-old Dominican leads the organization with seven triples.

PROMOTIONS: C/INF **Nic Gaddis** and OF **Rowley Jordan** were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday.

HELP IS ON THE WAY, DEARY: Three players were promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn ahead of this week in Delaware. No. 25 Mets prospect RHP **Christian Scott**, INF **William Lugo**, and RHP **Jeffrey Colon** have all been added to the roster.

SUOZZI SWATTING: OF **Joe Suozzi** has hit three homers over his past 15 games, hitting .308 with a .938 OPS. In the stretch, Suozzi is 16-for-52 with 10 RBIs. Suozzi is tied with OF **Jaylen Palmer** for the team lead in home runs with seven long balls.

HELLO: Mets No. 25 prospect Christian Scott makes his High-A debut after Monday’s promotion from Low-A St. Lucie.

GATOR BLUE TO MET BLUE: Scott was drafted by New York in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida, signing for around the slot value of \$350,000. At Florida, pitched as a reliever for his three years on campus, sitting mid-90s while touching 98.

COPYING MAD MAX: Christian Scott emulated New York Mets starter Max Scherzer’s slider grip. He uses his repertoire of fastball and slider while trying to incorporate a change-up.

CONTROL FREAK: The Floridian posted a 4% walk rate as a junior at Florida ahead of his draft selection. During his time with St. Lucie, Scott posted a 7% walk rate.

HIGH SCHOOL: Scott went undrafted out of Calvary Christian High School in Fort Lauderdale, FL -- a school that produced current No. 1 Philadelphia prospect Andrew Painter who is on the Jersey Shore roster.
