LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones snapped a 3-game losing streak with an 8-3 triumph over the Dash on Friday night...Brooklyn scored 3 in the first on a 3-run home run to right-center by CF **Alex Ramírez**...The 'Clones added 5 more in the second on a wild pitch, a C **Kevin Parada** single, and a 3-run clout from RF **Stanley Consuegra**...Winston-Salem scored on a 2-run blast from LF **Ben Norman** and a solo shot by RF **D.J. Gladney**...RHP **Raimon Gómez** (3.0 IP) punched out a career-high 7 in a no-decision for Brooklyn...LHP **Daniel Juárez** whiffed 5, earning the win...RHP **Andrew Dalquist** (1.2 IP) permitted 4 runs and suffered the loss for the Dash.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

GRAB SOME PINE: Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches on Friday night...Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory...RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start...LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodríguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief...The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The 17 strikeouts are tied for the most by a pitching staff in a South Atlantic League game this year...Aberdeen also struck out 17 in an 8-inning loss vs. Wilmington on April 8.

RED HOT RAMÍREZ: OF **Alex Ramírez** comes into the weekend riding a season-high 3-game hitting streak...The 20-year-old is 6-for-his-last-13 (.462) with 4 runs scored, a double, a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 walks...Ramírez has collected multiple hits in consecutive games and has registered at least 1 RBI in each game during the streak...The outfielder is tied for 3rd in the SAL in hits (9) and tied for 8th in total bases (14).

STAN AND DELIVER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has felt right at home in Winston-Salem this week...During the series, Consuegra is 6-for-16 (.375) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs, and 9 RBI...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI on Thursday...Consuegra's 4-hit game was the first for a Cyclone since C **José Mena** tallied 4 vs. Wilmington last September 1...The Dominican native's previous 4-hit night came with Brooklyn on July 13, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Coming into Saturday, Consuegra is tied for 2nd in the SAL in RBI (9), doubles (3) and extra-base hits (5)...He is also tied for 4th in total bases (17).

KING CÉSAR: INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style...The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 6 games in 2023...Berbesi is 8-for-21 (.381) at the plate with 7 runs scored,

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn travels to North Carolina for their first matchup against the White Sox' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 10 of the Pale Hose top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), INF **Loideli Chapellí** (26), and RHP **Andrew Dalquist** (28) are all on Winston-Salem's active roster...INF **Colson Montgomery** (1) and RHP **Jared Kelley** (14) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 in their first 12 matchups against the Dash in 2022...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 from Winston-Salem at Truist Park from September 6-11, the final series of the regular season.

a triple, and 4 RBI...Berbesi enters Saturday's game tied for 2nd in the SAL in walks (8)...He is also 3rd in OBP (.567), tied for 4th in runs scored (7), and tied for 10th in batting average (.381)...Berbesi has walked 74 times compared to only 83 strikeouts in 102 career games.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES: LHP **Quinn Brodey** and RHP **Manny Rodríguez** made their Cyclones pitching debuts on Saturday afternoon...Brodey yielded one run on one hit, striking out a pair, in 2.1 innings...Rodríguez did not permit a hit or run over 1.2 frames...As an outfielder, Brodey led Brooklyn in RBI (30) in 2017...Rodríguez appeared in 51 games as a shortstop with the franchise in 2018.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Ger vase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his Cyclones debut on Sunday afternoon vs. Jersey Shore...Did not allow a run on 1 hit over a career-high 4.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a career-best 5...Charged with a balk...Threw 63 pitches (36 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Jordan Geber** (4.1 IP, 3 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 4 SO) in the top of the 5th and the game scoreless...Brooklyn scored 4 times in the 7th — including a 2-run double by CF **Alex Ramírez** — and defeated Jersey Shore, 4-2.

2022: Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

SOARING EAGLE: Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

NEW ROLE: Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 3rd professional start on Saturday...In those outings, he has no record and a 1.42 ERA (1 ER in 6.1 IP), adding 10 strikeouts...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

SUMMER NIGHTS: The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.
