BROOKLYN CYCLONES (18-19, 18-19 at BOWLING GREEN HOT RODS (21-16, 21-16)

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its fifth-straight contest in a 6-5 loss at Bowling Green on Friday night...The Cyclones grabbed the lead with two runs in the top of the ninth on a RF Omar De Los Santos sacrifice fly and a 1B Karell Paz triple...However, the Hot Rods walked it off on a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and two walks...C Chris Suero collected a pair of knocks, including a go-ahead two-run home run in the seventh...CF Stanley Consuegra also collected a pair of doubles...RHP Douglas Orellana tied a season-long with five innings of work, allowing one run and striking out six in a no-decision.

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has reached safely all nine games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on May 7 at Rome and enters play on Saturday riding a 20-game on-base streak dating back to his time in the Florida State League...Since the streak began on April 20, the third-year pro is hittling .44I/.537/.500/1.037 with 14 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 16 stolen bases...The now 21-year-old is second in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.504), trailing only INF Trent Farquhar (.509) of Philadelphia's Single-A Clearwater...He is also third in batting average (.384), fifth in wOBA (.483), tied for seventh in stolen bases (20), and eighth in wRC+ (192)... The McLean, Va. native's three stolen bases on Wednesday tied nine others for the franchise mark in a single game...Morabito became the first Cyclone to collect three swipes in a single match since LF Alex Ramírez accomplished the feat on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.77...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit...That ERA is also fourth at the High-A level and ninth among full-season Mil.B squads...Cleveland's Double-A Akron holds the best mark in the minors (2.36), while Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.46) possesses the best ERA at the level..The Cyclones' II.39 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio is also fourth-best in Mil.B and second-highest at the High-A level.

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP Douglas Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Orellana is tied for fifth among South Atlantic League pitchers with 41 strikeouts...Additionally, among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the league in ERA (1.23) and ranks third in opposing OPS (.475), fifth in batting average against (.165), and sixth in WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP) is the fifth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-legit strikeout game of his career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 12-6 record at Maimonides Park, but a 6-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.32) in Minor League Baseball... Chicago-AL's Double-A Birmingham (2.06) has the lowest mark in Mil.B...Additionally, the Cyclones are fifth in opposing OPS (.570) and eighth in batting average against (200) in home games...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.73..They also maintain a .689 opposing OPS and a .245 batting average against on the road.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career...On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 151 innings in a no-decision on May 10 at Rome...Over his last five starts, McLean is 2-1 with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing just 15 hits and six walks (7.14 BB%), adding 30 strikeouts (35.71 K%)...On the year, among pitchers with 28.0+ innings, he is ninth in the South Atlantic League in fewest hits allowed (20)...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run last Wednesday...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 29 fewer plate appearances (65) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and 12 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 65+ plate appearances, McLean is seventh in the league in slugging (.541).

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine last Saturday and his team season-high-tying on-base streak was snapped at 12 in the opening game of Thursday's doubleheader....The 23-year-old is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in triples (2) and tied for ninth in doubles (8).

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 69 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...The 23-year-old is also seven hits away (157) from matching OF **Alex**

vs. BOWLING GREEN: Brooklyn continues its only twoweek road trip of the season against the Rays' High-A affiliate...The Hot Rods possess eight of Tampa Bay's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: 1B Xavier Isaac (3), INF Brayden Taylor (4), OF Chandler Simpson (10), INF Tre' Morgan (13), OF Colton Ledbetter (14), RHP Yoniel Curet (16), RHP Trevor Martin (19), and INF Cooper Kinney (22)...This marks the third-ever series between Bowling Green and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Brooklyn dropped 4-of-6 in their first visit to Bowling Green Ballpark in 2022...The Cyclones are 5-11 against Hot Rods in 16 all-time meetings.

Ramírez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

OMAR-I-GONE: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on May 2 vs. Aberdeen, OF Omar De Los Santos (59) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT Jaylen Palmer (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF Walter Rasquin's (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...Omar is 15 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 81 in 2024...De Los Santos is 22-for-24 stealing bases to start the season...The 22 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and third-most throughout the minors...Bowling Green's OF Chandler Simpson (31) leads the SAL and MiLB...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is third across the Minors in steals (129)...Simpson is second in MiLB (133).

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 28 free passes are the fourth most in the league...Lugo's 20.7% walk rate is also fifth in the league and 14th in all of Minor League Baseball.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 10 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,000-847 (.541) in 1,847 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 202-216 (.483) in 418 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP Jonah Tong's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...ln eight appearances (six starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER in 31.1 IP)...Tong is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.86)...The Markham, Ont. native is also third among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (39.5%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.7%) is eighth...Tong's 51 strikeouts are tied for 11th-most in the minors.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 51 career outlings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.58 ERA (23 ER in 80.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 19 and striking out 70. striking out 70.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: Brooklyn's 6-3 win over Rome on May 10 marked the Cyclones' first win in extra innings in 2024...The Cyclones had started the season 0-2, dropping contests on April 7 at Wilmington and May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Friday was Brooklyn's first win in added frames since a 13-12 triumph in 10 innings at Asheville on August 24, 2023...Since the start of 2023, the Cyclones are 7-10 in extra-inning contests.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Nolan McLean** (No. 11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: McLean (19), Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF Nick Morabita (26) Top 30 per MLB: McLean OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss of the season last Sunday afternoon at Rome...Surrendered four runs on four hits over a season-low 2.2 innings...Walked two and struck out four... Permitted a solo home run to SS **E.J. Exposito** in the bottom of the second...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** with a man at third, two out, in the bottom of the third and Brooklyn trailing 4-0...The Cyclones ultimately dropped the series finale to the Emperors, 8-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final eight appearances (seven starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)... Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
