GAME ONE: Brooklyn toppled Aberdeen 8-1 Tuesday night in Coney Island to take a 1-0 series lead in the best-of-three North Division Championship Series, combining all three facets of the game: starting pitching, relief pitching, and hitting. RHP **Luis Moreno** spun six innings of one-run ball, striking out seven. RHP **Nolan Clenney** and RHP **Daison Acosta** combined for three perfect innings to close it out. Offensively, the Cyclones hit three home runs. OF **Joe Suozzi's** solo home run gave Brooklyn a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the second, OF **Matt Rudick's** fifth-inning blast made it 4-1, and INF **Jose Peroza's** two-run home run in the fifth pushed the lead to 6-1. Aberdeen's lone run came on OF **Jud Fabian's** solo home run in the top of the second inning.

PLAYOFF PREVIEW: Tonight continues the North Division Championship Series in the best-of-three series. Games Two and Game Three (if necessary) are at Aberdeen's Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium in Maryland on tonight and Friday. Aberdeen won the First Half of the North Division with a 43-23 record, winning by 7.5 games over Wilmington. Brooklyn won the Second Half of the North Division with a 40-26 record, winning by two games over Hudson Valley. The team that wins the series faces the South Division Champion in a three-game series starting Sunday.

RECENT PLAYOFF HISTORY: This season marks Brooklyn's first playoff berth in the South Atlantic League era that began in 2021. Brooklyn won the 2019 New York Penn League Championship in the final year of the league as a Short Season Class A club, clinching the first-ever outright title in the franchise's history. Since 2001, Brooklyn has made the playoffs 11 times, including this year's berth.

PITCHING & DEFENSE: Brooklyn ended the regular season having allowed 510 runs, ranking as the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball and the fewest in the South Atlantic League. Only the Minne-

vs. ABERDEEN: The Baltimore Orioles affiliate went 43-23 in the first half to win the North Division Title and then 35-31 in the second half. On the current roster, the IronBirds host six of the Orioles Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including 2022 Draft picks OF Dylan Beavers (No. 8), 3B Max Wagner (No. 16), and OF Jud Fabian (No. 23). Aberdeen also hosts prospects OF Heston Kjerstad (No. 10) and SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 26).

sota Twins affiliate, the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels of the Low-A Florida State League allowed more (502).

BEST STRETCH: Brooklyn ended the season with a 14-4 record in its final 18 games, outscoring opponents 111-51 (+60). Brooklyn's offense averaged 6.2 runs per game and the pitching staff and defense has allowed 2.8 runs per game over the stretch.

CHAMPIONS AGAIN?: The 2022 Cyclones have two players from the 2019 NYPL Championship roster, including C **Jose Mena** and INF **Jose Peroza**.

JOSE! JOSE! JOSE!: After bottoming out with a .199 batting average on June 29, INF **Jose Peroza** hit an astounding .336 over the final 58 games of the season, raising his batting average from .199 to .271. Peroza had a 31-game on-base streak from July 29-September 2 -- the second-longest in team history.

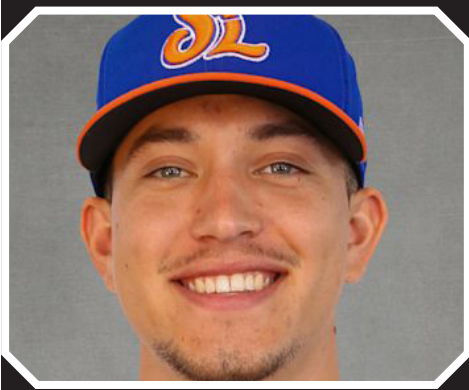
AN 'A' FOR ALEX: OF **Alex Ramirez** finished his regular season with 140 hits, ranking most among Mets minor leaguers and 18th all of Minor League Baseball, finishing 17 hits behind leader OF **Will Brennan** (Triple-A Columbus -- Cleveland). Ramirez, just 19 years old, played 67 games with St. Lucie, collecting 77 hits with a .284 batting average before his July 4th promotion to Brooklyn where he played 54 games with 63 hits and a .278 batting average. Ramirez also ended his regular season with a Mets MiLB-best 30 doubles and seven triples.

RANKINGS: Dominic Hamel ranks as the No. 12 prospect in the New York Mets organization and the No. 5 pitching prospect in the system.

METS ORG LEADER: Hamel finished the 2022 regular season with the most starts (24), the most victories (10), the most innings pitched (119), the most strikeouts (145), the second-lowest WHIP (1.15), the second-lowest opponents' batting average (.196), and the third-lowest ERA (3.25) in the Mets organization.

MASTERY: Last week in Winston-Salem, NC, Hamel went seven shutout innings for the second-consecutive time. Hamel struck out eight batters in the Thursday victory.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
