LAST TIME OUT: All three runs were scored in the 10th inning, as Brooklyn walked off Rome, 2-1, in extras on Wednesday afternoon...SS **Wilfredo Lara's** RBI single scored DH **Donovan Antonia** to give Brooklyn the victory...Brooklyn pulled even on a wild pitch when 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** darted home from third to tie the game...RHP **Jack Wenninger** was rock solid in his Maimonides Park debut, tossing 5.0 shutout innings, and giving up only one hit...Brooklyn's bullpen was stupendous...RHPs **Jeffrey Colón** (2.0 IP) and **Henry Henry** (1.0) combined on three one-hit shutout frames...RHP **Justin Lawson** picked up the first victory of his professional career, allowing only the automatic runner to come home to score in the top of the 10th...The game was Brooklyn's third extra-inning contest in the first five games of the homestand.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 25, 2004, INF **Danny Garcia's** No. 6 became the first player to have his number honored in Cyclones' history...Garcia became the first former Cyclone to appear in the Major Leagues on September 2, 2003, and is one of four players to have their number honored...In 2005, Brooklyn scored three runs in the top of the 11th inning on singles from 2B **Armand Gaerlan** and 3B **Josh Petersen** to win 5-2 at Batavia, earning the 200th win in franchise history...In 2011, CF **Travis Tajeron** hit a go-ahead grand slam in the top of the ninth during a five-run frame in a 9-5 win at State College...In 2013, OF **Julio Concepción** became the first active Cyclone to be traded in-season when the New York Mets traded him to the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slot Number 51 (\$366,500)...In 2021, 2B **Luis González** provided a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the ninth in a 5-4 win vs. Wilmington.

FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC: Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win on Wednesday afternoon marked the second time in the last five games that the Cyclones won via a walk-off single... On Friday vs. Jersey Shore, **Chris Suero** provided the game-winning RBI single with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5...**Nick Lorusso** delivered the first walk-off win of the year, clubbing a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...On the flip side, Brooklyn has suffered seven walk-off defeats this season, most recently a 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have surrendered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.91% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses, while earning 10 walk-off wins...27 of Brooklyn's 223 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.11%)...The Cyclones have also earned 21 wins in their last at-bat during that time.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks, while striking out 36...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (74)...He is also second in batting average against (.203), ERA (3.14) and WHIP (1.19), and 12th in innings pitched (57.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.06), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (110).

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old notched the go-ahead RBI single on Tuesday, in addition to scoring from second base on a sacrifice fly for an insurance run...The McLean, Va. native is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (41)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (67), is second in stolen bases (30), and tied for sixth in runs scored (41)...The former second-round selection is seventh in the SAL in stolen bases (30) and tied for ninth in batting average (.280) on the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.309), stolen bases (41) and on-base percentage (.408)...He is also second in hits (98) and runs scored (55), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

PAZ DISPENSER: Despite being placed on the injured list as of Thursday, OF **Karel Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .327/.426/.538 with a .964 OPS in 17 games...Paz has scored eight runs and picked up four doubles, two triples, a home run, six runs batted in, eight walks and seven stolen bases...Since that date, Paz is sixth in the SAL in on-base percentage (.426), seventh in OPS (.964), and tied for seventh in batting average (.327) and stolen bases (7).

GRAB A PINT-ARO: RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** has been on a tear over the past month or so...The Pelham, Ala. native surrendered only one unearned run over 4.2 frames of work in Tuesday's win over Rome...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, the veteran has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Pintaro is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00) and is fifth in batting average against (.160) and tied for eighth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...The Shorter University has unfortunately not received a bevy of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his six starts this season.

vs. ROME: Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Cade Kuehler** (7), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (12), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (17), and RHP **Blake Burkhalter** (26)...RHP **Owen Murphy** (4) and INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Despite being tagged with the loss on Saturday against Jersey Shore, Morris still holds a minuscule 1.63 ERA over his last five starts dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that five-game span (four starts) sits at 2-2...He has yielded just 21 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Morris is fifth in the circuit in ERA (1.63) and Tong is sixth (1.75)...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (27.2), ninth in batting average against (.204), and 11th in WHIP (1.12)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is fifth in the league in innings pitched (51), seventh in batting average against (.231) and eighth in ERA (3.33) and WHIP (1.25).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has five multi-hit efforts in his last nine games...Since July 6, he is 13-for-34 (.382) with four runs scored, a double, two RBI and three walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests.

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Before this week's six-game set against Rome, the Cyclones had just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's previous full six-game home series was June 18-23 vs. Jersey Shore...Brooklyn was 7-14 in the 21-game stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and played another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also included a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Since powering a 421-foot home run on July 13 at Wilmington, the 24-year-old has homered three times in his last five games, going 5-for-17 (.294) at the plate with six runs scored, a double, and five runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is fifth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .244/.327/.278 line with a .605 OPS, three extra-base hits, three RBI, and five stolen bases over 22 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .289/.354/.414 mark with a .768 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 36 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .261/.388/.420 with a .808 OPS, three home runs, and 16 RBI in 20 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (9), RHP **Jonah Tong** (15), RHP **Kade Morris** (23), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (26), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (19), Báez (21), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), OF **Nick Morabito** (25), and Morris (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in the first game after the All-Star break last Friday night vs. Jersey Shore...Yielded three runs on six hits over 3.2 innings...Walked one and struck out four...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 75 pitches and 45 strikes (60.00%)...Relieved by RHP **Luis G. Moreno** with a runner at second and two out in the top of the fourth and Brooklyn trailing 2-0...Bequeathed runner scored...Trailing 5-0 and down to their final strike twice, the Cyclones rallied in the ninth to tie the game on a RF **Omar De Los Santos** two-run home run...C **Chris Suero** provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5 Brooklyn victory.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 15 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the consensus highest-rated pitching prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

THE TONG SONG: Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with an 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks (7.14 BB%), while striking out 36 (36.73 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (74), ERA (3.14), batting average against (.189), and WHIP (1.14), and 10th in innings pitched (57.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.08), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and tied for ninth in strikeouts (110).

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: The 21-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zach Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
