ABOUT LAST NIGHT: LHP Nick Zwack lowered his June ERA to 0.47 with five scoreless innings and six strikeouts en route to Brooklyn's 2-1 victory over Jersey Shore. With the victory, the Cyclones won the first game of the second half. Zwack outdueled Philadelphia's No. 2 prospect RHP Mick Abel who struck out eight over 6 1/3 innings of two-run ball. Brooklyn C Jose Mena homered in the third inning and OF Jaylen Palmer yanked an RBI single in the fourth inning to make it 2-0. Cyclones reliever RHP Sammy Tavarez earned the final four outs to secure the save.

**JERSEY SHORE** 

KLUECLAWS

**FIVE MILLION:** Today the Cyclones will celebrate yesterday's major milestone. Friday night marked a major accolade in the history of the Brooklyn Cyclones. The team entered Friday just 177 fans away from the five-million mark since the team's inception in 2001. Last night, 5,573 came through the gates to cross over the plateau. On August 19, 2015 Pete Mulvey walked through the gates as the four-millionth fan.

**SECOND HALF START:** Yesterday, Friday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36 and, while the full season record is still kept, all 12 teams' records reset to 0-0 to begin the second half. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 28 home runs in the past 33 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia farm system returns to Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening home series of the year April 12-17. This season, the Cyclones have won 11 of the 16 games in the series. Jersey Shore hosts nine of Philly's Top 30 prospects, including No. 1 and No. 2 prospects RHP Andrew Painter and RHP Mick Abel. OF Johan Rojas is the No. 4 prospect in the organization.

JT JOLTING!: 1B JT Schwartz clobbered a three-run home run on Sunday at Wilmington, his second of the season. During June, Schwartz is hitting .308 with a .349 on-base percentage. The No. 19 New York Mets prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, is slugging .460 after slugging just .317 in May and .362 in April. During this month, Schwartz has hits in 14 of 19 games.

THE GRANT POOBAH: RHP Grant Hartwig earned his sixth save of the year last night, sitting one off the the league leader (Jason Ruffcorn -- Jersey Shore -- 7). Hartwig is a perfect six for six in saves and owns a staff-best 43.5% strikeout rate. The former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 12 innings.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.34 earned run average in 24 games with 13 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

MURPHY'S NEW LAW: OF Tanner Murphy has been on a tear over his past eight games, going 11-23 (.478) with a double, triple, and two home runs -- good for an .870 slugging percentage over the stretch and a 1.390 OPS. Murphy is hitting .260 over 25 games with Brooklyn this year. Last year, Murphy hit just .181 through 23 High-A games.

**BRYANT IS BACK:** Bryant returns to the mound for his sixth start and 12th appearance. Last time out, Bryant tossed six innings for the first time since 2019.

AS STARTER: Bryant has started five games, posting a 4.13 ERA with a 25% strikeout rate and a 6% walk rate.

AS RELIEVER: Coming on as a piggybacker, Bryant has pitched in relief six times, posting a 3.63 ERA with a 23% strikeout rate and a 9% walk rate.

2021: Bryant spent 2021 with the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, breaking camp with the team in May. He made two starts before tearing his oblique in May. Did not pitch again until mid-August with the FCL Mets. Made one appearance with the Cyclones in September, allowing a career-high four home runs against Hudson Valley on September 8th.

2019 SEASON: Bryant put his name on the radar in 2019. leading the Cyclones pitching staff to a New York Penn League Championship over the Lowell Spinners. That season, Bryant was named to the mid-season All-Star team. Bryant struck out 75 batters in 75 innings and pitched a pair of seven-inning games for the Cyclones.

MAN, YOU MOVE: Bryant grew up in Deerfield, New Hampshire but moved to and grew up in the Clearwater, FL area. Bryant now makes his home in Saratoga Springs, NY.
