Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Tides play a doubleheader after the rainout last night. DL Hall and Aaron Ashby will get the starts for Nashville in game one and two respectively. Right-hander Brandon Young and left-hander Bruce Zimmerman will start for the Tides.

DL Hall: The 25-year-old makes his ninth start with the Sounds this season. Nearly the end of his rehab stint, Hall was struck with a line drive on his arm that forced him to leave his last start against Iowa on July 9. In that start, he tied a season-high with five strikeouts across two plus innings. He has seen a steady increase in pitch count with 62, 61 and 54 pitches in his last three starts. The Valdosta, Georgia native was drafted by the Orioles in the first round in 2017 out of high school. He pitched for the Tides in 2022 and 2023 and made his debut for the Orioles in 2022. He has pitched 22 times at Harbor Park in his career. He entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to Baseball America after being acquired along with Rookie of the Year hopeful, Joey Ortiz in an offseason trade for Corbin Burnes.

Aaron Ashby: The 26-year-old makes his 17th appearance and 13th start of the season for the Sounds. He is 2-5 with a 7.66 ERA (69.1 IP/59 ER) with the Sounds on the season. He has also made two starts for Milwaukee, going 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA (8.2 IP/6 ER). Ashby last pitched on July 10 and took the win vs. Iowa at First Horizon Park. After rehabbing Brewers starter Joe Ross pitched 3.2 scoreless innings, Ashby followed to start the fifth and went the rest of the way (6 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 7 K). Entering today, the Missouri native leads the International League with 60 walks. He spent most of his 2021 season with Nashville before joining the Brewers rotation for most of the 2022 campaign. Ashby missed the entirety of Milwaukee's 2023 season, only making a handful of appearances in the minors on rehab assignment in September. The southpaw was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

Brandon Young: The 25-year-old makes his 10th appearance and eighth start with Norfolk tonight. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA (37.1 IP/16 ER) for the Tides. He began the season with Double-A Bowie, going 0-2 with a 4.09 ERA (22.0 IP/10 ER) across seven outings (6 starts) for the Baysox. Young made two starts in the series at Memphis on July 9 and July 14. He did not receive a decision in either of those, going four innings in both (2 H, 1 ER, 3 BB, 4 K on July 9 and 3 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 2 K on July 14). It is the first time Young is pitching against the Sounds. He made his Triple-A debut on May 29 vs. Gwinnett (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 6 K). He was signed by Baltimore as a free agent in 2020 after playing collegiately at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette.

Bruce Zimmerman: The 29-year-old makes his 11th appearance (10th start) for the Tides this season. In his last start, he allowed four earned runs in 4.1 innings of work at Memphis on July 10 and was charged with the loss. He has 38 career appearances (27 starts) for the Orioles dating back to 2020 which includes seven appearances out of the pen this season. He was drafted by the Braves in the fifth round in 2017 and was acquired by the Orioles in a deal that included Kevin Gausman. The Baltimore native attended the University of Mount Olive in North Carolina. He became the 28th Maryland-born player to play with the Orioles.

Other Rehab News: Right-handed reliever Devin Williams has been added to Nashville's roster for tonight's contest. The two-time NL All-Star, NL Reliever of the Year and 2020 NL Rookie of the Year pitched last Sunday with High-A Wisconsin, retiring the side in order for the Timber Rattlers. This is his first appearance with Nashville in his career. Also, Jared Koenig returned to the Nashville bullpen on rehab assignment from Milwaukee on Friday night. Koenig began the season with Nashville before having his contract selected by Milwaukee on April 14.

Collins Cooking: Isaac Collins extended his on-base streak to 16 games on Friday night, going 3-for-5 with three runs, two doubles and a RBI. It's his second 16+ game on-base streak this season, having a 17-game streak from May 10-29. Collins is batting .295 (18-for-61) with nine extra-base hits, 10 walks and nine runs scored since the streak began on June 25. The Maple Grove, Minn. native leads the IL in doubles (25), is tied for the league-lead in extra-base hits (40, with Memphis' Luken Baker) and ranks among league leaders in triples (T-2nd, 5) and runs (T-8th, 56).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 732-628 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,324-2,148 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has never faced Norfolk but pitched in 39 games (29 starts) for the Tides in 2022-23 before being acquired by the Brewers in the offseason.
