LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn fell in its series finale against Hudson Valley on Sunday, 42...Despite the loss, the Cyclones received strong outings from both RHP **Jonah Tong** in a scheduled abbrevaited start (2.0 IP, 0 R, 1H, 3 K), and RHP **Drew Smith** - on major-league rehab (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 BB, 2 K)...The Renegades broke a 2-2 tie in the ninth on a throwing error by 3B **William Lugo** that plated a pair...Gilbert **Gomez's** squad did bring the winning run to the plate in the bottom of the ninth, but C **Carlos Oviedo** struck out looking with men on the corners to end the ballgame.

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley...LHP Felipe De La Cruz grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF Nick Lorusso was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits... On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/588/1286 with a whopping 1874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday... Thursday... Be sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021...LHP Gunnar Kines and OF José Miguel Medina were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter their series against Jersey Shore with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but an 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the ninth-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago-AL's Birmingham (2.01) has the lowest mark in Mil.B...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP Felipe De La Cruz put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gsellman accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play with the eighth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68)...The Domincan native is also tied for sixth in strikeouts (50).

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra has been on a tear lately... Brooklyn's all-time leader in extra-base hits (73), home runs (33), and RBI (108) homered in back-to-back contests last week - a grand slam Friday and leadoff home run Saturday...Against Hudson Valley last week, Consuegra logged an OPS over 1.000 thanks to those two home runs and four walks...The 23-year-old is also one hit away (163) from matching OF Alex Ramírez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)... On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

BASEBALK: The Cyclones' pitching staff set a dubious record on Saturday night, being charged with five balks...No team in Minor League Baseball has been charged with more than four...Since the MiLB stat portal began in 2005, no full-season team had ever been charged with 5+ balks in a single game...It has only occurred seven times in total and three times outside of the complex level...In 2023, the ACL Dodgers and DSL Pirates Blue were called for five on July 3 and June 8, respectively...The high-water mark is six by the DSL Cardinals on July 7, 2008.

NICK THE QUICK: OF NICK Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old is fourth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.482), tied for fifth in batting average (.356), and tied for ninth in stolen bases (23)...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 15 games.

DOU NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in last Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is eighth in batting average against (1.75), and 10th in WHIP (1.06)....Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched two more home runs in Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley, marking his second multi-home run game of the year...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso is tied for second in OPS (.938) and triples (3), third in slugging (.550), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (18), seventh in RBI (25), eighth in total bases (71), and 10th in batting average (.295)...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for first in triples (3), third in OPS (.938) and extra-base hits (17), and tied for fifth in total bases (71)...The Connecticut native is currently on an eight-game hitting streak since May 16, slashing .379/.514/.793/1.307...In that time, Lorusso has added a double, a triple, three home runs, and six RBI.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Justin Crawford (4), SS Bryan Rincon (7), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), and LHP Samuel Aldegheri (23)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 49-40 (.551).

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP Kade Morris put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round selection by the Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits, while striking out seven and walking only one batter, all en route to earning his first career win...RHP Jonah Tong tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP Tyler Stuart (6.0 IP) and RHP Blade Tidwell (6.0) accomplished the feat on July 5 and 6, 2023, at Wilmington.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball..The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames... In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (4 ER in 40.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Milor League Baseball in ERA (0.90)...Only Arizona's LHP **Spencer Glesting** (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in Mil.B in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.4%) is eighth...Tong's 62 strikeouts are tied for seventh-most in the minors.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.67...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.48 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.15)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fourth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.23).

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Last Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF William Lugo has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 36 free passes are the second most in the league... Lugo's 21.3% walk rate is also second in the league and sixth in Minor League Baseball.

AND THEY'RE OFFI: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF Omar De Los Santos and RF Nick Morabito each stole three bases, while CF Stanley Consuegra added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome... Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH Walter Rasquin and RF José Miguel Medina each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B Edgardo Fermín and CF Quinn Brodey snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,006-849 (.542) in 1,855 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 208-218 (.488) in 426 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.62 ERA (25 ER in 86.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 75.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: Kade Morris (21), Jonah Tong (22) and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).



.AST TIME OUT: Earned his first professional victory in his High-A and Cyclones debut last Wednesday afternoon vs. Hudson Valley...Allowed just one run on four hits over 6.0 innings... Walked one and struck out seven...Plunked a batter and induced a double play...Tossed 85 pitches and 56 strikes (65.88%)...Relieved by RHP Brett Banks to start the top of the seventh inning with Brooklyn leading, 2-1...Cyclones went on to defeat the Renegades, 3-1.

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to Baseball America...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shut-out innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

KADE YOU DIG IT: At the time of his departure, Morris ranked among the Florida State League leaders in several categories...The 21-year-old ranked sixth in the circuit in innings pitched (34.2) and ninth in ERA (3.63)...Morris also was seventh in strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.87) and ninth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17... Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
