LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn's 3-game winning streak was snapped in Sunday's series finale at Jersey Shore, 12-7...The BlueClaws scored 3 runs in the 1st and added 5 more in the 2nd...Brooklyn trimmed an 11-1 deficit down to 12-7 in the 8th, but could not complete the comeback...Jersey Shore clubbed 4 home runs...DH **Devin Saltiban** slammed a leadoff solo home run in the 1st, CF **Raylin Heredia** added a solo blast to start the 2nd, RF **Eduardo López** tacked on a 3-run shot in the 2nd, and 1B **Bryson Ware** clubbed a solo homer in the 6th...RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** garnered his 1st home run of the season, a solo shot in the 3rd...LF **Carson Bengé** tallied 2 hits, and SS **Boston Baro** drove in a pair.

NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn made a plethora of roster moves on Monday...The Cyclones added INF **AJ Ewing**, RHP **Chandler Marsh**, and INF **Marco Vargas** from Single-A St. Lucie...In corresponding moves, RHP **Ryan Lambert** and LHP **Zach Thornton** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while INF **Nick Roselli** was transferred to St. Lucie...RHP **Eduardo Herrera** was reinstated from the Development List, and RHP **Layonel Ovalles** was placed on the Development List...Ewing was hitting .400/.506/.615/1.121 in 18 games with the Mets, adding a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 stolen bases...The 20-year-old led the Florida State League in steals (14), batting average (.400), on-base percentage (.506), OPS (1.121), and hits (26)...Ewing is also tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4), 5th in batting average (.400) and OPS (1.121), tied for 6th in stolen bases (14), and 7th in on-base percentage (.506)...Marsh held a 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 10.2 IP), and 1 save, allowing only 2 hits and 1 walk with 14 strikeouts over 8 appearances...Among FSL pitchers with 10.0 or more innings of work, the 22-year-old was 5th in the circuit in strikeout rate (41.2%) and 7th in walk rate (2.9%)...Vargas slashed .409/.527/.545/1.072 in 13 games with St. Lucie, collecting a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 steals...Before joining Binghamton, Lambert did not receive a decision and held a 1.13 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP), allowing 3 hits, walking 1, and striking out 17 in 7 appearances...Thornton was dominant for Brooklyn, hoisting a 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...The southpaw leaves the South Atlantic League with a league-best ERA (0.44), tied for the league lead in wins (3), 2nd in WHIP (0.68), 6th in batting average against (.162), and tied for 7th in innings pitched (20.2) and strikeouts (25)...Thornton is 6th in the minors in ERA (0.44) and 9th in WHIP (0.68)...Roselli hit .133/.220/.222/.422 with 7 runs batted in over 13 games for Brooklyn.

HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY: INF **Estarling Mercado** has been red hot with the bat to start 2025...The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season on Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Sunday, Mercado is hitting .405 (17-42) with 6 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 8 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 8 of 9 games, posting a .452 average (14-31) with 4 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 7 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 50 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks 2nd in batting average (.405), 4th in OPS (1.075), 7th in slugging percentage (.595), and 8th in on-base percentage (.480).

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Despite taking the loss last Tuesday, over his first 4 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), 22 strikeouts and only 13 hits allowed...Entering Tuesday, Hall is 5th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.45)...His 54.5% ground ball rate is also good for 3rd-best in the circuit...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: UTL **DAndre Smith** is off to a marvelous start in 2025...The Diamond Bar, Calif. native is currently riding a 6-game on-base streak, going 8-for-19 (.421) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base.

DONUTS FOR DÍAZ: RHP **Joel Díaz** has put nothing but donuts on the scoreboard to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old has not allowed a run on 9 hits with 2 walks and 18 strikeouts in 15.2 innings over 4 appearances (2 starts)...Díaz is 1 of only 2 pitchers at the High-A level to throw 15.0 or more innings and not allow an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg**)...He is the only one not to allow a run at all...Díaz is 1 of 4 arms across Minor League Baseball to not allow a run over 15.0 or more innings on the hill...Double-A Altoona's LHP **Hunter Barco** (17.2 IP) and Double-A Somerset's RHP **Brendan Beck** (15.0), and Single-A Stockton's RHP **Donny Troconis** (16.0) are the others...Among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings, the right-hander enters Tuesday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00)...The San Cristóbal, D.R. native is also 4th in the circuit in WHIP (0.70) and 8th in batting average against (.161).

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 18 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.70 ERA (24 ER in 80.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 97-to-28 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.70 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (.292)...It is also 2nd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (1.65) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 3.14 ERA (60 ER in 172.0 IP), which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 2nd-lowest in the SAL behind only Quad Cities (2.26) and Hudson Valley (2.87)...The 3.14 ERA ranks 11th in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.26) holds the top spot.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Cyclones relievers have an 8-2 record with a 3.52 ERA (36 ER in 92.0 IP), 4 saves, 54 walks, and an eye-popping 130 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.14 WHIP for relief arms is tied for the lowest at the High-A level with Hudson Valley and tied for 6th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Erie (0.99) is 1st...Additionally, the Cyclones have accrued a 12.72 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio, which is the best at High-A and 4th-best in MiLB...Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa (13.95) holds the best mark in the minors...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a .163 batting average against, which is the 2nd-lowest mark in MiLB...Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.157) is 1st...The Cyclones also maintain an impressive 34.39% strikeout rate.

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer registered 5-straight multi-hit games from April 13 vs. Hudson Valley until April 18 at Aberdeen, earning New York Mets Minor League Player of the Week on April 21...The 21-year-old was also named to MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" after hitting .421 (8-19) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 4 RBI in 5 games...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 6th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in doubles (8) and triples (3)...Reimer is also tied for league lead in extra-base hits (13), 4th in hits (23) and total bases (43), tied for 4th in RBI (16), 5th in slugging percentage (.566), 6th in OPS (.935), and 7th in runs scored (15).

SUPER SUERO: C **Chris Suero** has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-week road trip, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking 4-of-6 at home against Aberdeen...The Cyclones swept the initial series with the 'Rocks taking all 3 games from April 4-6 on Coney Island...Wilmington is 0-9 on the road this season...The Blue Rocks boast 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: INF **Seaver King** (4), LHP **Alex Clemmey** (5), C **Caleb Lomavita** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (17), LHP **Jackson Kent** (20), OF **Elijah Green** (24), and OF **Brenner Cox** (30)...Bennett is currently on the injured list...In 110 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 60-50 (.545)...Brooklyn is 34-20 in 54 home games against Wilmington (.630).

2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Tuesday, Suero is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (5) and slugging percentage (.625), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (11), 4th in OPS (.998), tied for 4th in RBI (16) and doubles (6), and 7th in total bases (35).

ELI'S ELITE NIGHT: OF **Eli Serrano III** put together his best game as a professional in Thursday night's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano is the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B **Luke Ritter** also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF **Alex Ramirez** was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Tuesday, Serrano is tied for 9th in the South Atlantic League in walks (15).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 12 runs and 17 hits en route to a 12-5 win at Jersey Shore on Thursday...It marked the 2nd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 17 or more hits in a single game...The Cyclones accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...Thursday marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It is also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

REMEMBER ME?: Brooklyn's roster features a former Wilmington Blue Rock entering this week's 6-game set...C **Onix Vega**, who is currently on the Cyclones' Development List, spent parts of 3 seasons with the Blue Rocks from 2022 until 2024...In 91 games with Wilmington, the 26-year-old hit .251/.364/.360/.724 with 42 runs scored, 21 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 39 RBI.

RAIN, RAIN GO AWAY: The Cyclones endured their 2nd rain out of the 2025 season when Saturday's matchup at Jersey Shore was washed out...The contest will be made up with a pair of 7-inning contests when Brooklyn returns to ShoreTown Ballpark from May 20-25...Brooklyn's first rain out of the season came on April 11 vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones split the ensuing doubleheader, dropping the opener, 2-0, and winning the nightcap, 2-1...In 2024, Brooklyn went 7-5 in 12 twinbill games and 2-1-3 in doubleheaders overall.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss on April 16, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP **Noah Hall** sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Ryan Lambert**, and RHP **Alfred Vega** united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones' offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 3 alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 10 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Bengé** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22) and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), and INF **AJ Ewing** (27)...Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Bengé (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Bengé (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).

LAST START: Suffered a tough luck defeat last Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...Surrendered only 1 run on a season-high 7 hits over 4.0-plus innings...Walked 2 and struck out 4...Charged with a wild pitch...Threw 76 pitches and 47 strikes (61.84%)...Relieved by RHP **Anthony Nunez** with the bases loaded and nobody out in the bottom of the 5th and the game scoreless...1 of 3 bequeathed runners scored on a sacrifice fly...Retired the leadoff batter in 4 of 5 innings...The BlueClaws added 2 more runs in the 8th on sacrifice flies...Brooklyn broke up the shutout on a 3B **Jacob Reimer** double...The Cyclones put the tying runs in scoring position in the 9th, but dropped the series opener, 3-1.

NOAH'S ARC: After an injury-shortened 2024, Hall has returned to form in 2025...Despite taking the loss last Tuesday, over his first 4 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), 22 strikeouts and only 13 hits allowed...Entering Tuesday, Hall is 5th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.45)...His 54.5% ground ball rate is also good for the 3rd-best in the circuit.

HALL PASS: Hall started on Opening Day for the Cyclones for the second-straight year on 4/4 vs. Wilmington...The 24-year-old was Brooklyn's starter on Opening Day in 2024, taking the loss on 4/5/24 at Wilmington...Hall is the only pitcher in Cyclones history to start on back-to-back Opening Days and the only arm in franchise history to start the first game of the season multiple times.

2024: Spent most of the campaign with Brooklyn...Made his professional debut as the Cyclones' 2024 Opening Day starter on 4/5 at Wilmington...Suffered the loss, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits in 3.2 innings...Walked 3 and struck out 3...Best start of the season came on 4/18 at Jersey Shore...Allowed only 1 run on 4 hits in a career-high 5.0 innings...Walked 2 and punched out 3 in a no-decision...Placed on Brooklyn's 7-day injured list (shoulder) on 4/26...Transferred to 60-day IL on 5/12...Joined Single-A St. Lucie for a rehab assignment on 9/7...Combined to tally a 0-2 record with a 9.65 ERA (14 ER in 13.0 IP), 10 walks, and 12 strikeouts in 5 starts.

FREE FALL-IN': Following the 2024 season, Hall pitched for the Scottsdale Scorpions of the prestigious Arizona Fall League...Accumulated a 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (4 ER in 6.2 IP) and 3 strikeouts...Best outing came on 10/18 vs. Surprise...Allowed 1 unearned run on 1 hit over 3.0 innings, allowing 3 walks and striking out 2.

PALMETTO POWER: The Charlotte, N.C. native spent 2 years at the University of South Carolina before joining the professional ranks...Before missing the remainder of the 2023 season with a back injury, Hall garnered a 5-1 record, a 3.29 ERA (15 ER in 41.0 IP) and 43 strikeouts in 7 starts for the Gamecocks...The right-hander tallied 121 strikeouts in 117.2 innings over 22 appearances (19 starts) at South Carolina...He described South Carolina as his "dream school since I was a little kid"...He has multiple South Carolina alumni on his mom's side of the family and attended their sporting events as early as the age of 2 or 3.

APP-ETIZER: Before spending a pair of seasons at South Carolina, Hall was a member of Appalachian State University's baseball program in 2020 and 2021...Serving predominantly as a reliever, the 7th-round pick was named a Freshman All-American in 2021 by Collegiate

Baseball...In 28 appearances (5 starts) for the Mountaineers, Hall was 7-1 with a 3.36 ERA (36 ER in 69.2 IP), 4 saves, and 73 strikeouts.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: Hall was selected by the New York Mets in the 7th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina...The right-hander inked his deal with the organization, earning a \$176,250 signing bonus.

TAKE TWO: Hall was drafted for the second time in 2023...The Charlotte native was taken by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 20th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina, but did not sign.
