LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn surged back into the win column with a 3-2 victory over the Blue Rocks on Friday night to capture 3 of the first 4 games of the series...The low-scoring affair saw Major League rehabber RHP Paul Blackburn make the start for the 'Clones...Blackburn was dominant through his first 2.0 innings, striking out 5 batters, but did allow a pair of runs to score in the 3rd...Brooklyn's bullpen took the baton the rest of the way, with 4.1 innings of scoreless relief from RHP R.J. Gordon, and a 5-out save from RHP Anthony Nunez, the first of his pro career...Offensively, CF A.J. Ewing led the charge, notching 3 hits while driving in a pair...The 'Clones did all of their scoring in the 2nd, when Ewing laced a 2-run single to center, followed by an RBI fielder's choice from SS Boston Baro.

NUNEZ IS NAILS: RHP Anthony Nunez collected a 5-out save on Friday, the 1st of his career, to continue his marvelous start to the new year...The righty has yet to allow an earned run through his first 8 appearances of the season...The University of Tampa product did not surrender a mere base hit until his 7th appearance of the year...Among players in the South Atlantic with at least 12.0 IP, Nunez is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00)...He is 1 of 3 players not allow an earned run (Aberden's RHP Braxton Bragg & Hub City's LHP Larson Kindreich...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP leads the league amongst those with 12.0 IP, and is tops in all of High-A...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP is also the 2nd-lowest in Minor League Baseball among arms with 12.0 or more innings...Only Boston's High-A Greenville's LHP Brandon Clarke (0.35) has a lower mark...Nunez's 0.29 batting average against (1-35) is the lowest mark in MiLB.

BLAZIN' HOT BENGE: OF **Carson Benge** is one of the hottest hitters in the league entering play on Saturday...Even with his 7-game hitting streak coming to an end on Friday, Benge is still 14-for-his-last-34 with 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 9 runs scored, 5 batted in, and 5 walks...Benge picked up at least 2 hits in 5-straight games spanning from April 25 until May 1, including an outstanding 4-for-5 performance on Tuesday that saw him score twice and drive in a pair...Since April 13, Benge is tied for 2nd in the league in hits with 20.

ROARIN' RONALD: C/1B **Ronald Hernández** has been an integral piece of the puzzle for the Cy-clones all season...The switch-hitter enters Saturday on a 6-game hitting streak, during which he is 12-for-22 with multi-hit efforts in 4 games during the streak...During that span, Hernandez has compiled 8 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI..The 21-year-old has also made it a point to be more aggressive on the bases - Hernandez has already notched a career-high-tying 8 stolen bases across his first 18 games...Hernandez logged 8 steals last year over 108 games..

LUCKY NUMBER... 157: For the 2nd time in April alone, the Cyclones put up a 15-spot in a 15-1 win over Wilmington on Wednesday afternoon...Sure enough, the first time Brooklyn accomplished the feat this season also came against the Blue Rocks - also in the 2nd game of that particular series... The 'Clones bashed five home runs in their take down of the Nationals' affiliate on Wednesday, good for the most in a game this season...Wednesday's win saw Brooklyn's run differential skyrocket to +50 on the year, trailing only Hudson Valley in the South Atlantic League at +55...The 15-1 win on April 5th came thanks to a bit of a different brand of ball - Brooklyn did not hit a single home run that da... Brooklyn had not scored 15 runs in a single game at Maimonides Park since 2010.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alum-ni will have already accomplished the feat in 2025 by the end of the weekend...OF **Rhylan Thomas** (2023) had his contract selected by the Seattle Mariners from Triple-A Tacoma on Wednesday and went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night at Texas...Additionally, Mets manager **Carlos Mendoza** announced Friday that RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2023) will make his MLB debut for New York on Sunday at St. Louis...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debutd for the Chicago White Sox a day later, toxsing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty **France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer became the 1st player in 20 years to record a 3-home run game for the Cyclones...He is 1 of only 3 players in the history of the franchise to do so, joining Caleb Stewart on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley and Noel Devarez on July 1, 2001, vs. New Jersey...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 8th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in doubles (8), is tied for the league lead in triples (3), and is tied for 4th in home runs (5)...Reimer also leads the league in extra-base hits (16), total bases (59) and slugging (.634), is tied for the league lead in hits (30), tied for 4th in RBI (21), 2nd in OPS (1.022), and tied for 2nd in runs scored (20).

DIALED IN DÍAZ: RHP Joel Díaz has been outstanding to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old's scoreless inning streak to start the year came to an end at 17.1 innings after allowing a run against Wilmington on April 30...The righty sports a 0.44 ERA, which is tops in the SAL among active players entering play on Saturday...His 0.68 WHP also leads the league, while boasting a 24.2 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The San Cristóbal, D.R. native is also 4th in batting average against (.164)

RUNNIN' WILDI: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on Tuesday saw them nab a franchise re-cord 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C **Chris Suero** and DH **Jesús Báez** each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal...Tuesday's performance catapulted Brooklyn upwards in the stolen base category across the South Atlantic League...Gilbert Gomez's crew enters Saturday with 40 stolen bags on the year.

40 stolen bags on the year. **NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK**: Brooklyn made a plethora of roster moves on Monday...The Cy-clones added INF AJ Ewing, RHP Chandler Marsh, and INF Marco Vargas from Single-A St. Lucie.. In corresponding moves, RHP Ryan Lambert and LHP Zach Thornton were transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while INF Nick Roselli was transferred to St. Lucie...RHP Eduardo Herrera was reinstat-ed from the Development List, and RHP Layonel Ovalles was placed on the Development List...Ewing was hitting .400/.506/.615/1121 in 18 games with the Mets, adding a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 stolen base...The 20-year-old led the Florida State League in steals (14), batting average (.400), on-base percentage (.506), OPS (1121), and hits (26)...Ewing is also tied for 27nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4), 11th in batting average (.386), 13th in OPS (1.074), tied for 5th in stolen bases (15), and top 20 in on-base percentage (.488)...Marsh held a 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 10.2 IP), and 1 save, allowing only 2 hits and 1 walk with 14 strikeouts over 8 appearances...Among FSL pitchers with 10.0 or more innings of work, the 22-year-old was 5th in the circuit in strikeout rate (41.2%) and 7th in walk rate (2.9%)...Vargas slashed .409/.527/.545/1.072 in 13 games with St. Lucie, collecting a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 steals...Before joining Binghamton, Lambert did not receive a decision and held a 113 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP), allowing 3 hits, walking 1, and striking out 11 in 7 appearances...Thorn-ton was dominant for Brooklyn, hoisting a 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...The southpawel He South Atlantic League with a league-best ERA (0.44), tied for the league lead in wins (3), 2nd in WHIP (0.68), 6th in batting average against (.162), and tied for 7th in innings pitched (20.2) and strikeouts (25)...Thornton was 6th in the minors in ERA (0.44) with in WHIP (0.68)...Roselli hit 1.337.220/.222/.2422 with 7 runs batted in over 13 games for Bro

HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY: INF Estarling Mercado has been red hot with the bat to start 2025.. The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season last Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-week road trip, Brooklyn re-turns home for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilm-ington enters the series after taking 4-of-6 at home against Aberdeen...The Cyclones swept the initial series with the Aberdeen...The Cyclones swept the initial series with the 'Rocks taking all 3 games from April 4-6 on Coney Island... Wilmington is 1-12 on the road this season...The Blue Rocks boast 7 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects: INF Seaver King (4), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), LHP Jake Bennett (17), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (24), and OF Brenner Cox (30)...Bennett is currently on the injured list...In 114 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 63-51 (.553)...Brooklyn is 37-21 in 58 home games against Wilmington (.638).

run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Saturday, Mercado is hitting .367 (18-49) with 7 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 10 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 10 of 11 games, posting a .395 average (15-38) with 5 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 9 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 55 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks 4th in batting average (.367).

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 24 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.97 ERA (32 ER in 97.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 121-to-29 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.97 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (3.00)...It is also 3rd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (2.02) has the lowest mark at the lev-le...Qverall, Brooklyn's pitching staffs in the S outh Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (3.00)...It is also 3rd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (2.02) has the lowest mark at the lev-el...Qverall, Brooklyn's pitching staff in the sa 3.10 ERA (72 ER in 209.0 IP), which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 2nd-lowest in the SAL behind only Quad Cities (2.50) and Hudson Valley (3.01)...The 3.10 ERA ranks 6th in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.50) holds the top spot.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Satur-day, Cyclones relievers have a 10-3 record with a 3.21 ERA (40 ER in 112.0 IP), 5 saves, 57 walks, and an eye-popping 154 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.06 WHIP from relief arms is the lowest at the High-A level and 4th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Erie & Miami's Double-A Pensacola are tied for 1st (0.97)...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a .164 batting average against, which is the 2nd-lowest mark in MiLB...Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.153) is 1st.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen..On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Saturday, Suero is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (5), 6th in slugging percentage (.563), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (11), 5th in OPS (.951), tied for 9th in RBI (16), tied for 8th in doubles (6), and tied for 7th in total bases (36).

ELI'S ELITE NIGHT: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in Thursday night's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano is the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brookyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...ZB Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...ZB Auex Ramirez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley... Entering Saturday, Serrano is tied for 8th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (9).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win v. Wilmington on Wednesday...It marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24th's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

REMEMBER ME?: Brooklyn's roster features a former Wilmington Blue Rock entering this week's 6-game set...C Onix Vega, who is currently on the Cyclones' Development List, spent parts of 3 sea-sons with the Blue Rocks from 2022 until 2024...In 91 games with Wilmington, the 26-year-old hit .251/.364/.360/.724 with 42 runs scored, 21 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 39 RBI.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On May 3, 2024, RHP Brandon Sproat, tossed 5.0 shutout innings against Aberdeen, allowing only 1-base hit in a 2-0 Brooklyn win...Sproat walked 4 while striking out 8 batters..The victory improved the current No. 1 prospect in the Mets organization to 2-0 on the young season, and lowered his ERA to a minuscule 0.92...The former Florida Gator would make just one more start at the High-A level – a pitcher's duel with current Atlanta Braves RHP Spencer Schwellenbach – in early May at Rome – before being promoted to Double-A Binghamton with 1B/OF Ryan Clifford.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss on April 16, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP Noah Hall sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...HHP Ryan Ammons, RHP Ngan Lambert, and RHP Alfred Vega united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 10 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and INF A.J. Ewing (27)... Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also posses 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his 3rd defeat of the year last Sunday afternoon at Jersey Shore...Taxed for a career-high 5 runs on just 3 hits in 1.1 innings...Plunked a batter and walked 2 without recording a strikeout...Yielded a pair of home runs in the first 2 innings...DH Devin Saltiban led off the home 1st with a solo home run...CF Raylin Heredia added a solo blast of his own to lead off the 2nd...Threw 53 pitches and 28 strikes (52.83%)...Relieved by RHP Ben Simon with a runner at 1st and 1 out in the bottom of the 2nd inning and the Cyclones behind 4-0...Bequeathed runner scored...Brooklyn fell behind 11-1 after 5 innings, but rallied to trim the deficit to 5 in the 8th inning...The BlueClaws ultimately took the series finale, 12-7.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America...* Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

SPRING BREAKOUT: Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** during the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

DEVILISHLY GOOD: Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

DUAL THREAT: During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

FAMILY TIES: Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.).
