ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT: Behind a solo home run from OF **Joe Suozzi** breaking a scoreless tie in the seventh inning, the Cyclones defeated the Winston-Salem Dash 3-0. RHP **Jeffrey Colon** spun a career-high seven innings of scoreless baseball on just 68 pitches. With the victory and a Hudson Valley loss, the night culminated with a playoff celebration as the Cyclones clinched the Second Half North Division Title in the South Atlantic League.

PLAYOFF BOUND: Brooklyn has been crowned the Second Half North Division Champions, going to the South Atlantic League postseason for the first time in team history and the first time the franchise has made the playoffs as a full season club. Brooklyn faces the Aberdeen IronBirds Tuesday in Coney Island to open up a three-game set with the following games coming on Thursday and Friday (if necessary) in Maryland.

ELECTRIC FACTORY: OF **Joe Suozzi** hit a memorable home run on Friday night. The Long Island native who grew up in Glen Cove and played high school baseball at Chaminde High School in Mineola, is playing for a Mets organization he grew up rooting for.

SEND ME A POSTCARD: Brooklyn travels down to Winston-Salem for the first time in team history. After the realignment of the Minor Leagues, the Cyclones and Dash joined the South Atlantic League in 2021. Brooklyn hosted the Dash in August in Coney Island and heads to Truist Stadium for the first time. Brooklyn has still not matched up with league opponents Rome or Hickory since the realignment.

BEST STRETCH: Brooklyn is currently 13-2 in its past 16 games, outscoring opponents 104-42 (+62). Brooklyn's offensive is averaging 6.5 runs per game and the pitching staff and defense has allowed 2.6 runs per game over the stretch.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox High-A affiliate is currently in last place in the South Division in the second half. The Dash host none of the White Sox Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Brooklyn split a six-game series with Winston-Salem in Coney Island August 2-7. The Dash has played at Truist Stadium since 2010. Baseball in Winston-Salem dates back to 1905 and even the Brooklyn Dodgers had a farm team in WS in 1938.

JT IS JUST TERRIFIC: Since August 21st, 1B **JT Schwartz** is batting .351 (26-74) with 16 runs scored, seven doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI over his last 17 games.

JOSE! JOSE! JOSE!: Since July 29th INF **Jose Peroza** ranks second in the SAL with a .356 average, he also leads the league in hits (48) and doubles (14) over this stretch...Peroza also ranks in the top 10 in walks (21), extra-base hits (17) and total bases (71).

STAN THE MAN: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is batting .480 (12-25) over his last six games with a .500 on-base percentage... The outfielder has five RBI in these six games with a 1.020 OPS.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: Brooklyn is tied for the South Atlantic League lead with a .977 fielding percentage...The team has committed 103 errors in 4,572 total chances, also tied for the fewest in the SAL.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and are tied for the second-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 501 runs in 129 games (3.9 runs/game).

RUDY! RUDY! : OF **Matt Rudick** is batting .316 (18-57) with nine runs scored, five doubles, a triple, and seven RBI over his past 14 games...He also has a .403 on-base percentage over the stretch.

INNINGS EATER: Santos ranks fourth in the Mets organization with 112.2 innings pitched, sitting 6.1 innings behind the leader and teammate RHP Dominic Hamel. Last year, Junior tossed 96 innings as a career high.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

BREAKOUT: The 21 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

HELLO: Mets No. 28 prospect Christian Scott makes his sixth High-A start and second this week against Winston-Salem.

PITCH COUNT: Scott has not lasted more than four innings per outing with the Cyclones as the Mets have him on a strict pitch count/innings limit. With Brooklyn, Scott has been capped at no more than 80 pitches (last outing).

GATOR BLUE TO MET BLUE: Scott was drafted by New York in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida, signing for around the slot value of \$350,000. At Florida, pitched as a reliever for his three years on campus, sitting mid-90s while touching 98.

COPYING MAD MAX: Christian Scott emulated New York Mets starter Max Scherzer's slider grip. He uses his repertoire of fastball and slider while trying to incorporate a change-up.
