BLUE JAYS NOTES

- The Dunedin Blue Jays fell to the Daytona Tortugas 6-2 in their series finale on Sunday afternoon at TD Ballpark.
- RHP Gilberto Batista (4 IP, 4 R, 1 ER, 7 H, 1 BB, 1 K) took the loss, allowing four runs (one earned) in four frames with a strikeout.
 - o All four runs allowed by Batista came in the first inning, with three coming home via the long ball.
 - Over his first six appearances (three starts) this season, Batista has a 2.08 ERA in 26 innings with 19 strikeouts.
- C Edward Duran (2-for-5, HR, 2 RBI, RBI) launched a two-run homer to left-center field in the 6th inning to account for Dunedin's only runs of the day.
 - O Duran's homer left the bat at 105.3 MPH, his hardest hit ball of the season.
 - Over his last nine games, Duran is batting .324 with a home run and eight RBI.
 - He has hit safely in three straight and eight of his last nine.
 - Duran has homered three times over his first 20 games this season, after he went homerless in 77 games for Dunedin in 2024.
