**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Hudson Valley won a pitchers' duel against Brooklyn, escaping with a 2-1 victory on Saturday night. The Renegades broke a 1-1 tie in the bottom of the sixth, scoring on an RBI single by INF **Trey Sweeney** to make it 2-1. Brooklyn's RHP **Luis Moreno** took the tough-luck loss, allowing two runs over a High-A best six innings and a career-high nine strikeouts. The Cyclones tied the game in the top of the fifth on a throwing error that scored OF **Joe Suozzi** from first base. Renegades arms RHP **Yoendrys Gomez**, RHP **Jhonatan Munoz**, and RHP **Ryan Miller** combined to hold Brooklyn to one run.

**SEVEN AND COUNTING:** 1B **JT Schwartz** extended his hitting streak to seven games with a double last night. Schwartz now has the team's longest streak and looks to extend it today. INF **Shervyen Newton** and OF **Rowdey Jordan** both had six-game hitting streaks.

**METS-YANKS:** Brooklyn faces Hudson Valley 30 times this season. The Renegades have won nine of the 17 games. The Cyclones are hitting just .169 with a .291 on-base percentage against the Renegades over 16 games with a 31% strikeout rate. Against the rest of the league, the Cyclones are hitting .220 with a .312 on-base percentage with a 25% strikeout rate.

**JUNE BUGS:** LHP **Nick Zwack** allowed one earned run in June, tossing 25 innings and posting a 0.36 ERA. 1B **JT Schwartz** led the team with 37 total bases, hitting .299. OF **Jaylen Palmer** hit three home runs.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 32 home runs in the past 40 games after just seven over the

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The New York Yankees farm club has won nine of the 17 games with the Cyclones with 13 left to play. The Renegades host seven of the Yankees' Top 30 prospects, including a trio of Top 10 prospects: No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 10 OF Everson Pereira. The Renegades are managed by first-year skipper Tyson Blaser and are in their second year with NYY.

**THE GRANT POOBAH:** RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned his seventh save of the year Thursday night which is tied with four other players for the league lead. Hartwig is a perfect seven for seven in saves and owns a staff-best 42% strikeout rate. The undrafted free agent and former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 14 1/3 innings.

**ARMS STRONG:** Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

**FIVE MILLION:** This past home series against Jersey Shore, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night.

**SECOND HALF START:** Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

**K-STATE:** The 6-foot-5 righty transferred to Kansas State after one year at Darmouth, sitting for the 2019 season due to NCAA transfer rules before pitching for two seasons in the Big 12 Conference.

**GOOD COMPANY:** Seymour’s college teammate at Kansas State, RHP Jordan Wicks, was selected 21st overall by the Chicago Cubs and signed for \$3.1 million.

**DYNAMIC DAD:** Carson’s father Brian was a professional tri-athlete (swimming, biking, running), finishing the Hawaii Ironman competition four times.

**FROM MANHATTAN (KS) TO QUEENS:** Seymour was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets and signed for \$291K. The last time the Mets selected a player directly from Kansas State, they drafted 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones OF Jared King who reached as high as Double-A Binghamton.
