LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its third-straight contest, 13-4, on Tuesday night at Hudson Valley...The Cyclones carried a 2-0 lead into the fifth, but the Renegades scored five in that frame, six in the sixth, and two in the seventh... LF Nick Morabito collected a team and game-high-tying three hits, stealing a base and scoring a rum...C Chris Suero and 2B Jefrey De Los Santos each tallied a pair of knocks with the latter driving in a rum...RHP Jawilme Ramírez took a no-decision for Brooklyn after tossing 4.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball...9-of-10 batters for Hudson Valley picked up at least one hit and all 10 reached base safely at least once...The contest was Brooklyn's longest nine-inning game of the year at 3:20...It is the longest nine-inning game played by the Cyclones since a 3:47 ballgame on July 21, 2023, also at Hudson Valley.

THE CENTURY MARK: RHP Michel Otañez became the 100th player in Brooklyn Cyclones history to make the trip from Coney Island to the Major Leagues, making his Major League debut for the Oakland Athletics on Monday night...The 26-year-old threw 0.2 scoreless innings in San Diego allowing a hit and a walk...Otañez made seven starts for Brooklyn in the 2019 season and 35 relief appearances during the 2021 campaign...In 42 appearances (seven starts), the right-hander held a 5-2 record with a 4.20 ERA (33 ER in 70.2 IP), one save, 58 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Otañez is the second former Cyclone to make his Major League debut in 2024...RHP Christian Scott (2022-23) was the first to do so for the New York Mets on May 4.

CROWN CONSUEGRAI: In a win at Jersey Shore on May 29, OF Stanley Consuegra's RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones' all-time hits leader (179), breaking a tie with OF Alex Ramfrez...Last Saturday, Consuegra's one-out doubles in the ninth inning broke his tie with Ramírez for the franchise record in doubles (39)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season mome run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on a 12-game on-base streak and has a hit in 18 of his last 20 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .333/.449/.681 with a 1.130 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 66 points (.171 to .237) and his OPS by 251 points (.519 to .770) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in slugging (.681) and OPS (1.130) and is tied for first in home runs (6).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is tied for fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.461)...He is also tied for eighth in batting average (.346) and tied for ninth in stolen bases (27)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league lead in steals (16), sixth in runs scored (24), and 10th in on-base percentage (.406).

FETTUCINE WILFREDO: INF Wilfredo Lara has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 19 games and tallied a .339/.443/.523 line with a .966 OPS...Lara has scored 16 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, 10 walks, and four stolen bases... Among South Atlantic League players, the Dominican native is tied for sixth in runs scored (16), eighth in on-base percentage (.443), and tied for eighth in batting average (.338) in that span...Lara is also riding a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley...He is hitting .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF Junior Tilien enters play with the longest active onbase streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 20 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .297/.389/.446 slash line with a .835 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, and 11 RBI...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF José Peroza reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022... Tilien also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

SUERO SUAVE: C Chris Suero has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 16 of 17 games, hitting .328/.466/.552 with a 1.018 OPS...The Bronx native has

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate... Hudson Valley possesses five of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), INF Tyler Hardman (25), and OF Jace Avina (28)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 144-147 (.495).

scored a whopping 18 runs with a double, four home runs, and 16 RBI...Since that date, Suero is tied for fourth in the SAL in runs scored (18), fifth in on-base percentage (.466), eighth in OPS (1.018), and tied for eighth in walks (14) and RBI (16).

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF Jefrey De Los Santos has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old has accrued a seven-game hitting streak since the beginning of June and has tallied multiple knocks in six of his last nine games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting .395/.439/.816 with a 1.255 OPS, seven runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, and seven RBI...During the seven-game hit streak, the left-handed swinger is batting .433 (13-30) with six extra-base hits, a .833 slugging percentage, and a 1.302 OPS...In June, De Los Santos is second in the circuit in slugging (.833) and OPS (1.302) and fourth in batting average (.433).

VOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen... The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP Chayce McDermott, RHP Nolan Hoffman, and RHP Kaleb Ort combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP Dylan Cumming, RHP Nick Sinacola, and LHP Seth Corry of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH:** Including Wednesday, eight games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are in fourth place, 3.0 games back of Jersey Shore for first in the North Division.

GET YOUR OFFENSE HERE!: In back-to-back games on SNY, the Brooklyn Cyclones erupted for a season-high-tying 13 runs and 14 hits in Thursday's 13-3 win vs. Aberdeen and followed it up with 13 more runs and a season-best 18 hits in a 13-7 win on Friday...The 13 runs were the most for the Cyclones since a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...The 14 knocks were also the most for Brooklyn since a 14-hit outing in a 9-7 win at Jersey Shore on April 20...Friday's 18-hit effort was the best for Brooklyn since they accumulated 18 knocks in an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on July 21, 2023...The 18 hits were the most for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park in almost 13 years...Brooklyn racked up 20 hits, also against Aberdeen, in a 13-0 rout on July 21, 2011...Friday marked the first time the 'Clones accrued 13+ runs and 18+ hits in the same game since scoring a franchise-record 20 runs in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...It was the first time Brooklyn accomplished those numbers at Maimonides Park that 13-0 win vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 58 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.48 ERA (26 ER in 94.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 83.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)... Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gsellman accomplished

the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings... Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 43.0+ innings of work, the southpaw is fifth in ERA (2.89). WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of
