Today's Game: It's the series finale at First Horizon Park as the Sounds and Knights close out their first clash of 2024. Chris Roller sent the sellout crowd home happy, hitting a walk-off homer for a 5-3 win. Tyler Woessner will get the start, working for the first time since last Sunday. He'll be opposed by Jonathan Cannon, who pitched the series opener on Tuesday for the Knights. The first pitch is scheduled for 2:05 p.m. central.

Tyler Woessner: The 24-year-old makes his fifth appearance and fourth start of the season this afternoon for Nashville. He is 1-2 with a 9.20 ERA (14.2 IP/15 ER) for the Sounds after starting 0-1 with a 2.66 ERA (20.1 IP/6 ER) with Biloxi. Woessner entered in the second inning of last Sunday's game at Jacksonville. He allowed a pair of runs (1 ER) in 3.2 innings of work, walking four with a strikeout. Woessner's last outing at First Horizon Park was his debut for the Sounds. Needless to say, it did not go well for the Central Arizona Junior College product, allowing eight runs (all earned) on five hits and four walks and lasting just 1.2 innings. This is Woessner's third season in professional baseball - he is 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA in 36 appearances (32 starts) in the Brewers' minor league system. The Phoenix, Arizona native was selected in the sixth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft by Milwaukee.

Jonathan Cannon: The 23-year-old right-hander will be making his seventh start for the Knights in 2024. He is 1-3, with a 5.67 ERA (27.0 IP/17 ER) and 27 strikeouts. He has three starts with the White Sox this season going 0-1, with a 7.24 ERA (13.2 IP/11 ER). He took the loss in the series opener on May 21, lasting just four innings while allowing six runs (5 ER). With only two starts at the Triple-A level, Cannon made his MLB debut on April 17 against Kansas City. He was efficient, going 5.0 innings, allowing one earned run on 79 pitches. With struggles in his next two MLB starts, he returned to Charlotte at the beginning of May. Cannon has been able to keep the ball in the park, allowing just one home run in his five starts with Charlotte. He was drafted in the third round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Georgia. He currently ranks as the No. 11 ranked prospect in the White Sox system per MLB Pipeline.

Sounds Are Hot: With the triumph last night, the Sounds have their longest winning streak of the season at five games. Their previous high of four was set in the last series at Jacksonville. Currently, it is the longest active winning streak in the International League. The Sounds also have the best record over the last 11 games (9-2) in the league. Since being no hit by Norfolk back on May 3, Nashville has won 14 of their last 19 games. Only the Omaha Storm Chasers, who currently are in the drivers seat in the league standings, have more (15-4). With a win today, Nashville will have their first six-game sweep since beating Gwinnett in all six games at First Horizon Park from June 13-18 last season. This would be the first time the Sounds have swept Charlotte since Nashville joined the International League in 2021.

In the Air Tonight: Isaac Collins extended his on-base streak to 14 games after adding a single last night. The switch hitter is batting .340 (16-for-47) with four doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, nine walks, 14 runs and a .475 on-base percentage since the streak began on May 10. It is tied for the second-longest on-base streak by a Sounds hitter this season (also Owen Miller from March 29-May 2). Yonny Hernandez's 15-game on-base streak from April 2-20 is the longest. Collins has hit safely in each of his last six games and is batting .450 (9-for-20) with six RBI and four runs scored.

Hicklen is Locked In: After being held without a hit through the first four innings yesterday, Brewer Hicklen came through with a double to break up the no no in the fifth. He later added another double and walked. Hicklen has been on fire in the series, batting .467 (7-for-15) with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, eight RBI, three walks and seven runs scored. He has a 1.333 slugging percentage and 1.889 OPS this week - both stats are the best by any hitter in the league this week.

That's Some Quality Stuff: With Carlos Rodriguez's quality start on Friday, the Sounds have had a total of 10 quality starts in 49 games this season (4 by Chad Patrick and Carlos Rodriguez, 1 by Evan McKendry and Tyler Woessner). Only Memphis (14), Lehigh Valley (14) and Gwinnett (12) have had at least 10 quality starts by members of their respected pitching staff this season in the league.

Welcome to Hit City: Yesterday, the Brewers acquired right-hander Garrett Stallings from Baltimore in exchange for recently designated for assignment Thyago Vieira and right-hander Aneuris Rodriguez. Stallings has been added to Nashville's roster after starting the 2024 season with Triple-A Norfolk. He has made 11 appearances for the Tides, going 0-1 with a 5.67 ERA (27.0 IP/17 ER), 1.63 WHIP and .282 opponent batting average. Stallings faced the Sounds twice in the series from April 30-May 5, appearing on April 30 (0.2 IP, 1 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 4 BB, 0 K) and on May 4 (3.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 2 K).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 710-606 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,302-2,126 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).
