LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its second-straight contest on Tuesday night at Greenville, 6-1...Game was delayed an hour and 14 minutes due to rain in the top of the 6th... Drive took the lead for good in the bottom of the 2nd on a 2-run double from 2B **Max Ferguson**...Ferguson collected 2 doubles in the game...Drive added 3 in the 5th thanks to 3 errors...Cyclones broke up the shut out in the 8th on a SS **Jett Williams** walk and a RF **Stanley Consuegra** triple...RHP **Noah Song** (5.0 IP), RHP **Juan Daniel Encarnación** (0.1), RHP **Reidis Sena** (1.2), and RHP **Felix Cepeda** (2.0) combined on the 2-hitter...RHP **Saúl García** tossed 3.0 innings of 1-run ball out of the bullpen in his Brooklyn debut.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight play-off appearance and has won 7 of their last 11 series since dropping 4-of-6 to Greenville on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 7-2-2 in their last 11 sets...Brooklyn is 32-23 in the second half and a half-game ahead of Jersey Shore (32-24) atop the North Division of the SAL with 11 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

NOT IDALIA: Weather conditions due to Hurricane Idalia prompted yesterday's postponement between Brooklyn and Greenville...The rain out was the first postponement of any kind in 83 days for the Cyclones since their game on Thursday, June 8, vs. Greenville was pushed back due poor air quality resulting from smoke caused by Canadian wildfires...It was also Brooklyn's first rain out in 102 days dating back to May 20 at Hudson Valley...The Cyclones have struggled mightily in doubleheaders this year...Brooklyn is 0-4-1 in twinbills in 2023, holding a 1-9 overall record...Thursday will mark the Cyclones first double dip since the team dropped both two vs. Greenville on June 10...Brooklyn lost the lid-lifter, 9-2, in 7 innings and fell in the nightcap, 2-1, in 8 frames.

JETT THE MET: INFs **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .328/.485/.611 with a 1.096 OPS, 29 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 18 RBI, 39 walks, and 15 stolen bases in 38 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 170 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.485)...He is also 2nd in OPS (1.096), 3rd in walks (39), 9th in slugging percentage (.611), and 12th in batting average (.328)...On the season, Williams is tied for 6th in Minor League Baseball in walks (93)...Among teenagers, Williams is tied for 1st in MiLB with San Diego's OF **Samuel Zavala** at High-A Fort Wayne...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 100 PA) in batting average (.318), on-base percentage (.469), OPS (1.049), doubles (8), and walks (24)...He is also tied for 1st in extra-base hits (13), 2nd in hits (28) and slugging percentage (.580), and tied for 2nd in stolen bases (9)...Among SAL players with at least 110 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is leading the circuit in walk rate (21.2%), is 2nd in OBP (.469), and 5th in wRC+ (.185), wOBA (.468), and OPS (1.049).

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th last Wednesday night...He added another blast last Thursday and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS **Jett Williams** (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...Entering Thursday, Consuegra is tied for 5th in the SAL in home runs (19) and 6th in slugging percentage (.474)...Over his last 11 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .267/.340/.667 with a 1.007 OPS, 5 home runs, and 13 RBI.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Wednesday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.497), tied for 3rd in home runs (20), and 5th in OPS (.841)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.250), and 5th in wOBA (.373) and wRC+ (.125).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Despite having a 3-game multi-hit streak snapped on Tuesday, Lugo has collected a knock in 5 consecutive games and 9 of his last 10...Over his 5-game hitting streak, the 21-year-old is 9-for-22 at the plate (.409) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, 5 RBI, and 2 walks...Since August 15, Lugo has 6 multi-hit contests in 12 affairs...The Dominican native is slashing .362/.412/.489 with a .901 OPS...Lugo has also scored 5 runs, picked up 4 doubles, a triple, and 11 RBI.

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.46 ERA (300 ER in 779.1 IP) over their last 89 games, holding a 49-40 record in that span, which is 4th lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.38) leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.45) is tops in the circuit...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in MiLB — in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.644) and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.21) and batting average against (.217).

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 2nd

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn closes out a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive possess 6 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Roman Anthony** (2), C **Kyle Teel** (4), RHP **Luis Perales** (7), SS **Eddinson Paulino** (16), 2B **Mikey Romero** (19), and OF **Allan Castro** (27)...Romero is currently on the 7-day IL...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the second time in this season...The Drive took 4-of-6 from the Cyclones from June 6-11 at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn and Greenville have met once at Fluor Field from May 11-16, 2021...The Drive won 4-of-6 contests in that series.

in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

THE BROOKLYN BATTING COMPANY: The Cyclones' streak of home runs in 7-straight games dating back to August 18 vs. Hudson Valley ended on Saturday night...The 7-consecutive games with a home run set a new franchise record dating back to the start of Minor League Baseball's stat portal in 2005...The previous high had been 6-straight games last accomplished from September 5-10, 2021, vs. Wilmington and at Hudson Valley...Brooklyn blasted 15 round-trippers during the streak for an average of 2.14 per game...The Cyclones also tied a season-high with 4 home runs in Thursday's win at Asheville...Brooklyn also blasted 4 long balls in a 6-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 23...The Cyclones smashed 11 home runs (1.83 HR/G) in the first 6 games of the road trip against the Tourists, scoring 49 total runs (8.17 R/G).

BINGO BOUND: With 6 strikeouts on Friday night, RHP **Joander Suárez** broke a tie with RHP **Blade Tidwell** (112) for Brooklyn's single-season strikeout record...The 23-year-old holds the all-time mark with 118 punchouts in 2023...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...On Tuesday, he and C **Kevin Parada** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton...Over his last 12 appearances (11 starts) with the team, Suárez held only a 4-5 record, but a 3.34 ERA (21 ER in 56.2 IP), 17 walks (7.3 BB%), and 79 strikeouts (33.8 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 8 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native was 2-4, yet holds a 2.72 ERA (13 ER in 43.0 IP) with 10 walks (5.7 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (34.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez was tied for the SAL lead and tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (63)...Parada was reinstated off the injured list prior to last week's series at Asheville, going 5-for-24 (.208) with 2 doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 5 games...Over his final 42 games with Brooklyn, the 22-year-old slashed .287/.344/.509 with an .853 OPS...Among players with 180-plus plate appearances, Parada ranked 5th in the SAL in slugging (.509), 7th in OPS (.853), and 8th in batting average (.287)...For the season, the Pasadena, Calif. native was 9th in the league in doubles (21).

THE HITS KEEP COMING: Brooklyn and Asheville united for 25 runs in the Cyclones' 13-12 win in 10 innings last Thursday night...The 25 tallies are the most combined runs in a single game for the 'Clones in 2023...It is tied for the 3rd-largest combined score in a South Atlantic League game this season...Aberdeen won at Greensboro, 16-14, in 9 innings on July 5, for a total ledger of 30 runs...The 25 combined runs were the most in a single game featuring Brooklyn since May 27, 2022...The Cyclones and Bowling Green Hot Rods united to scratch across 26 runs in Brooklyn's 20-6 victory.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (119), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clásé** (118), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilder Patiño** (118), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (114), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (113) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win with a quality start in his Brooklyn debut last Wednesday at Asheville...Permitted 4 runs (3 earned) on 5 hits over a career-high-tying 6.0 innings...Walked 4 and struck out 6...Induced a double play...Tossed 94 pitches and 51 strikes (54.3%)...Relieved by RHP **Benito García** to start the bottom of the 7th with Brooklyn leading 6-4...Cyclones scored 3 in the 8th and 3 more in the 9th to topple the Tourists, 12-5.

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts) since his start on July 2 vs. Dunedin, De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.4%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.73)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz is 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.

2022: Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Composed a 1-2 record with a 4.83 ERA (17 ER in 31.2 IP), 16 walks (11.6 BB%), and 44 strikeouts (31.9 K%)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 3...Made 2 scoreless appearances, earning a save...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 4.0 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 9 (69.2 K%)...Made 1 appearance for St. Lucie in their FSL Championship run...Permitted 1 run on 4 hits over 3.1 innings in relief during Game 1's victory at Dunedin...Walked 1 and struck out 4.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his second-straight no decision last Thursday night at Asheville...Permitted a career-high 7 runs on 7 hits over 2.2 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 1...Surrendered a 2-run home run to 3B **Tyler Whitaker** in the 1st and a solo home run to C **Ryan Wroblewski** in the 3rd...Threw 63 pitches and 42 strikes (66.7%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** with Brooklyn trailing 6-3, a runner at 2nd and 2 out in bottom of the 3rd...Bequeathed runner scored...Cyclones and Tourists exchanged leads into extra innings where Brooklyn prevailed, 13-12, in 10.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: Ramírez was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on August 3...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.
