BROOKLYN CYCLONES (23-29) vs. GREENVILLE DRIVE (29-24)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones collected their 5th walk-off win of the season on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...DH Kevin Parada powered a go-ahead solo home run in the 7th and provided the walk-off RBI single in the 9th, as part of a 3-hit game...Greenville tied it in the 8th on a sacrifice fly...Trailing 5-2, C Drake Osborn pounded a game-tying 3-run shot in the 6th and scored the winning run, starting the rally with a single...SS William Lugo tallied 2 hits and an RBI, while CF Alex Ramírez singled, walked twice, and stole a pair of bags...LF Nick Decker posted 2 hits — both doubles — and an RBI for the Drive...LHP Eli Ankeney retired all 6 batters he faced, earning his first Cyclones victory.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** After Thursday's postponement due to poor air quality, the Cyclones will battle Greenville in a doubleheader on Saturday...Friday will stil be a single 9-inning game...Brooklyn was swept in Saturday's twinbill at Jersey Shore, dropping to 1-7 in doubleheader games in 2023...All 4 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...The 'Clones are 22-22 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games this year.

RAMÍ ROCKETS: CF Alex Ramírez homered for the second-straight game on Tuesday night vs. Greenville...The 20-year-old pounded a game-tying 3-run home run to left in the 7th inning...Ramírez also tallied a solo blast in the 6th inning of Sunday's 9-3 win at Jersey Shore...It marked the 2nd time this season a Cyclone player has homered in consecutive games...RF Stanley Consuegra first accomplished the feat on April 14 and 15 at Winston-Salem...Ramírez is now tied for the team lead in home runs (5) with Consuegra and INF Mateo Gil...Alex enters Friday on a 4-game hitting streak...He is 6-for-his-last-13 (.462) with 6 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 steals in that time...Since joining Brooklyn on July 4 of last year, the Mets' No. 2 prospect per MLB Pipeline leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (63), hits (109), doubles (26), extra-base hits (37), total bases (167)...Ramírez is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (63) trailing only teammate IF/OF Jaylen Palmer (65), and INF José Peroza (69).

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 1th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramfrez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 1th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign... 21.2% (11-of-52) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

REMEMBER US?: This week marks the first time a Boston Red Sox affiliate has played at Maimonides Park since the Cyclones captured the final New York-Penn League championship against the Lowell Spinners in Game 3 of the 2019 NYPL Championship Series on September 10, 2019...PH Alex Erro — who made the final out for Lowell on a strikeout against LHP Andrew Edwards — OF Nick Decker and OF Gilberto Jiménez appeared in that contest and are currently on Greenville's roster...Jiménez is presently on the 7-day injured list...Current New York Mets 3B Brett Baty started in all 3 games of the series for Brooklyn.

KEVIN CAN DO: C Kevin Parada extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a 3-hit performance on Wednesday...The 3 knocks matched a career-best...The 21-year-old is 15-for-his-last-46 (.326) with 2 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, and 3 walks...Parada holds a 125 wRC+ and .377 wOBA in that span...He is tied for 4th in the SAL in doubles (14)...Since the start of May, Parada is tied for 4th in the circuit in two-baggers (10) and extra-base hits (14), as well as tied for 9th in hits (33) and total bases (54).

GOING, GOING, GIL: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games GUING, GIL: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .268/.369/.571 and he has registered an impressive .941 OPS, 149 wRC+, and .416 wOBA in that time...Gil is 15-for-56 at the plate (.268) with 11 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 3rd in the league in home runs (4), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (9) and RBI (13), 5th in slugging (.571), and 7th in OPS (.940).

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 21 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 49 earned runs (65 total) on 140 hits through the last 178.0 innings...That is good for a 2.48 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the 2nd-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Washington's Single-A Fredericksburg leads MiLB (2.45)...Cyclones' pitching has walked 79 (10.6 BB%) and struck out 207 in that span (27.8 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 95-65, over the 21-game stretch...Brooklyn is 12-9 during that span.

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.15) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.48) is 2nd in the circuit and the Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.30) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.11).

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 5 of Boston's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: SS/3B Eddinson Paulino (9), RHP Wikelman González (12), 1B/3B Blaze Jordan (16), IF Brainer Bonaci (18), RHP Ángel Bastardo (24), and LHP Dalton Rogers (26)...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting **Dalton Rogers** (26)...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate in the regular season since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League.

NOT SO STUART LITTLE: At 6-foot-9, RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 251 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May... Stuart leads the SAL and all of High-A in ERA (1.43)...Only LHP Robby Snelling (1.30) of San Diego's Single-A Lake Elsinore has a lower mark...Stuart is also 9th in the circuit in WHIP (1.20)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (87.2%) and FIP (2.82), 3rd in XFIP (3.42), 4th in strikeout rate (29.1%), and 7th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.64). FIP (2.82), 3rd innings (10.64).

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6.5E) against him (6-55) against him.

1-2, E-STEP: After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 26 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .300/.364/.478 with a .841 OPS...Estep has accumulated 15 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 14 RBI in 99 plate appearances... The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 128 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 178 points in that time (.047 to .225).

JEFF JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón tossed another gem last Thursday night, earning his first win in 2023...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER in 13.1 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 2 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span in that span.

ALL GAS, NO TE-BRAKE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 6 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 3 walks over 9.1 innings, registering 15 strikeouts...That equates to a 42.9 K% (15/35).

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (97), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (97), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (94) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 39...Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Friday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (185), at-bats (610), plate appearances (730), runs scored (95), walks (100), and stolen bases (45)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) on May 23, add an RBI on May 27, and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (191), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and tied for 5th in hits (113).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)... INF William Lugo (23/26) and RHP Christian Scott (27/26) also appears on both lists... OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 18 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

**GREAT SCOTT!:** Scott punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory on May 27 vs. Winston-Salem...Over his last 3 starts dating back to Game 2 of a doubleheader on May 21 at Hudson Valley, he has allowed 1 run on 4 hits over 13.0 innings (0.69 ERA)...The former Florida Gator has walked 2 hitters and punched out 13.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on May 10...Collected a 3-3 mark with a 4.82 ERA (20 ER in 37.1 IP) and 52 strikeouts in 12 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Placed on the 7-day injured list on July 3 and reinstated on July 27...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 3.80 ERA (9 ER in 21.1 IP) with 25 K's in 6 outings (5 starts) with the Cyclones...Did not appear for Brooklyn in the postseason.
