LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was shutout for the 2nd-straight contest in a 6-0 loss at Jersey Shore on Sunday...The Cyclones have not scored since RF **Stanley Consuegra's** solo home run with 1 out in the top of the 6th inning on Friday night, a span of 21.2 innings...CF **Jett Williams** led the 'Clones offense with a pair of hits, a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and a stolen base...2B **D'Andre Smith** doubled for the only other Brooklyn knock...CF **Jared Carr** clubbed a 2-run home run for the BlueClaws in the 2nd and LF **Gabriel Rincones Jr.** added a solo home run in the 7th...Carr finished with 2 hits, adding a double and 3 RBI...3B **Otto Kemp** tallied a pair of hits, including a double and an RBI...RHP **Carlos Betancourt** (3.0 IP), RHP **Jack Dallas** (2.0), RHP **Malik Binns** (1.0), RHP **Cam Wynne** (2.0), and RHP **Jason Ruffcorn** (1.0) combined on the 3-hit shutout for Jersey Shore.

CHURVEY ISLAND: LHP **Joey Lucchesi** is scheduled to make a rehab start for the Cyclones on Tuesday night...Throws a "churve" that he holds it deep in his palm like a classic circle changeup, but snaps the pitch off like a breaking ball...PerStatcast, his curve had an average 8.9 inch vertical drop in 2019, which was the most movement of any pitcher's changeup by more than a full inch...Lucchesi was placed on Triple-A Syracuse's 7-day injured list on July 20 (retroactive 7/19)...In 12 starts (11 appearances) with Syracuse, the 30-year-old is 6-3 with a 3.99 ERA (30 ER in 67.2 IP) and 63 strikeouts...Lucchesi has also made 5 starts this season at the Major League level with the Mets...The southpaw composed a 1-0 record with a 4.43 ERA (11 ER in 22.1 IP) and 17 K's.

THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW: INFs **Jett Williams** and **Jacob Reimer** have made an impact since making their Cyclones debut last Tuesday...Williams has reached base safely in all 6 games played with the club and is 5-for-17 (.294) at the plate with 2 runs scored, a double, 2 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 8 walks to 6 strikeouts...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .333/.524/.583 with a 1.107 OPS, 5 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 23 walks, and 9 stolen bases in 19 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is tied for 5th in Minor League Baseball in walks (77)...Reimer picked up an RBI double and a 2-run home run in last Wednesday's win at Jersey Shore...Since June 1, the 19-year-old has recorded a .303/.428/.483 slash line with a .911 OPS, 31 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, and 26 walks in 43 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

CLIFFORD THE CYCLONE: OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster last Thursday...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...Clifford smashed a 2-run home run to right in his first at-bat and closed out his organizational debut with a 2-for-3 day, adding 2 walks and 2 runs scored on August 3 at Jersey Shore...Clifford was ranked as Houston's No. 3 prospect at midseason by Baseball America and is deemed the Mets' No. 6 farmhand by MLB Pipeline...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Tuesday leading the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.535)...He is also tied for 2nd in OPS (.887) and tied for 4th in home runs (17)...Among players with at least 250 plate appearances, Clifford is 1st in isolated power (.272), 4th in OPS (.887), and 6th in wOBA (.389) and wRC+ (135).

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, OF **Alex Ramírez** is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (38)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old has accrued multi-hit games in 6 of his last 14 outings...In that span, Alex is slashing .373/.406/.525 with a .931 OPS...Ramírez is 22-for-59 at the plate (.373) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, 4 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Ramírez is tied for the SAL lead in hits (22) during that span...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is tied with INF Luke Ritter for 2nd in franchise history in RBI (80) and is 11 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36) on Wednesday, tied 2nd in total bases (221) and hits (150), and 3rd in runs scored (78).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 20 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhylan Thomas** is slashing .373/.407/.440 with a .847 OPS at the dish and a 135 wRC+...Thomas has added 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 walks to only 5 strikeouts...The left-handed swinger has composed multi-hit efforts in 7 of his last 15 games dating back to July 18 at Hudson Valley, slashing .393/.414/.482 with a .896 OPS and 147 wRC+...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 45 fewer plate appearances (139 to 94)...Among players with 85 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 4th in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.359) and has two fewer strikeouts (6) than any other batter.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP **Cameron Foster** took the loss but punched out a career-high 12 on July 29 vs. Wilmington...The 12 punchouts are the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2023...Foster is the 3rd different Brooklyn arm to strike out 10+ batters in a single game this year...RHP **Tyler Stuart** whiffed 11 on June 22, while RHP **Blade Tidwell** has accomplished the feat 4 times...The Houston native is the first Cyclone pitcher to strikeout 12-plus batters in a single contest since RHP **Marcos Molina** collected 12 strikeouts on August 15, 2014, in a 7-0 win at Vermont...Foster is the first to accomplish the feat at home since RHP **Collin McHugh** collected 12 K's vs. Jamestown on August 8, 2009...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-2 record with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER in 44.1 IP) with 13 walks and 52 strikeouts over 9 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.7% from his overall numbers (28.3% from 24.6%) and his walk rate is down 1.9% (7.1% from 9.0%).

ACE GERVASE: RHP **Paul Gervase** has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 29 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 6th in ERA (1.45) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 40.0 IP)...The 2022 12th-round pick is 8th in MiLB among relievers in opposing batting average (.146)...Among SAL relievers with at least 40.0 IP, the Fuquay-Varina, N.C. native is 2nd in the circuit in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.12), hits allowed (22), and opposing OPS (.511), and tied for 4th in saves (6)...Gervase leads all Mets farmhands in strikeout rate at 35.2% (min. 40.0 IP).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 3.02 ERA (205 ER in 610.0 IP)

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess 4 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: C **Samuel Basallo** (6), C **Creed Willems** (25), RHP **Juan Núñez** (27), and RHP **Trace Bright** (30)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since the two side split a 6-game series from May 2-7...The Cyclones are 6-6 (.500) against the IronBirds in the first 12 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2002, Brooklyn is 122-111 all-time against Aberdeen (.524).

over their last 70 games, holding a 39-31 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.14) is 2nd in the minors and SAL...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts — which tied for 5th-most in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 10.8%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.624), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.01) and batting average against (.212) in that period...RHPs **Tyler Stuart** (1.80), **Blade Tidwell** (1.87), and RHP **Christian Scott** (2.35) hold the 1st, 2nd, and 4th best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 65.0 IP).

BULLPEN BOOM: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.41) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 4th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.10) leads MiLB.

TOP OF THE CYCLONE: Brooklyn 7-series streak without losing a set came to a close with Sunday's loss at Jersey Shore...Brooklyn had not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11, going 5-0-2...The Cyclones are 22-14 in the second half and hold a 3-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Hudson Valley and Jersey Shore (19-17)...Brooklyn is 3.5-games behind Hickory (25-10) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: RHP **Jawilme Ramírez** was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on Thursday night...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

AIR JORDANY: RHP **Jordany Ventura** set new career highs in innings pitched (71) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in Wednesday afternoon's win at Jersey Shore...The Dominican native allowed just 2 runs on 2 hits, walking only 2 on a season-high 93 pitches and 63 strikes...The 23-year-old tossed 2-full innings more than his previous high of 5.1 frames on July 21 at Hudson Valley...His 9 K's were 2 more than his previous best of 7 vs. Lakeland on April 20...In 4 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 24 prospect per *Baseball America* is 2-0 with a 3.20 ERA (7 ER in 19.2 IP), 11 walks (13.9 BB%), and 17 strikeouts (21.5 K%).

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF **Alex Ramírez** became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B **Marcos Cabrera** of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF **Sammy Sosa** (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF **Max Carey** (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF **Walter Radskin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (113), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clase** (111), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (111), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (110), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (107) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 48.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Monday...9 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), INF **Jett Williams** (3), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Christian Scott** (9), INF **Jacob Reimer** (10), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (16), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (24)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (20), RHP **José Butto** (25), RHP **Luis Moreno** (26), and OF **Rowdley Jordan** (27)...In all, 17-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in a start for Triple-A Syracuse vs. Rochester on July 15...Allowed 5 runs on 5 hits in 5.0 innings...Walked 3 and struck out 4...Tossed 83 pitches and 48 strikes (57.8%)...Relieved by RHP **Dennis Santana** to start the top of the 6th inning with Syracuse trailing 5-3...Mets rallied to tie the game in the bottom of the 9th on a 2-run single by LF **Ronny Mauricio** and won in the bottom of the 10th, 9-8, on a walk-off RBI single by DH **Danny Mendick**.

ON THE MEND: Lucchesi was placed on Triple-A Syracuse's 7-day injured list on July 20 (retroactive to July 19)...The 30-year-old made 8 rehab appearances across 3 minor league affiliates in 2022...Suffered a torn UCL in his left elbow on June 18, 2021, with the Mets at Washington...Underwent Tommy John surgery on June 24 and missed the remainder of that season.

2023: Started the season with Triple-A Syracuse...Made 3 starts and went 2-0 with a 2.30 ERA (4 ER in 15.2 IP) with 7 walks (10.9 BB%), and 16 strikeouts (25.0 K%)...Recalled by New York on April 21...Tossed 7.0 shutout innings — striking out 9 — to earn the win on April 21 at San Francisco in his first MLB start since 6/19/21 at Washington...Posted a 1-0 record with a 4.43 ERA (11 ER in 22.1 IP), 8 walks (8.6 BB%), 17 strikeouts (18.3 K%) in 5 starts...Optioned back to Syracuse on May 14...Tallied a 4-3 mark with a 4.50 ERA (26 ER in 52.0 IP), 23 walks (11.9 BB%), and 47 strikeouts (24.2 K%) in 9 appearances (8 starts) before landing on the injured list on July 20.

EAST COAST BOUND: Lucchesi was acquired by the New York Mets from the San Diego Padres in a 3-team trade on January 19, 2021...The Pittsburgh Pirates sent RHP **Joe Musgrove** to San Diego and the Mets traded C/OF **Endy Rodríguez** to Pittsburgh...The Padres also dealt RHP **David Bednar**, OF **Hudson Head**, RHP **Drake Fellows**, and LHP **Omar Cruz** to the Pirates to complete the swap.

BEST IN CLASS: The southpaw was selected to a Major League roster for the first time on March 30, 2018, and made his debut in a start later that day vs. Milwaukee...Lucchesi became the first pitcher in the 2016 draft class to make his MLB debut...The Newark, Calif.-born left-hander was selected by the San Diego Padres in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Southeast Missouri State University (Cape Girardeau, Mo.).
