ABOUT SUNDAY: Aberdeen scored six unanswered runs en route to a 7-2 series finale victory over Brooklyn on Sunday to win four of the six. RHP **Junior Santos** allowed two runs over five innings in the tough-luck loss, while Brooklyn's offense was sleepy until the final three innings. OF **Jaylen Palmer** broke up the IronBirds' no-hit bit with a single in the fifth. C **Matt O'Neill's** sacrifice fly in the seventh made it 6-1, while 1B **JT Schwartz's** RBI double in the ninth plated C **Nic Gaddis** to make it 7-2.

GREEN AROUND THE GILLS: For the first time ever, the Greensboro Grasshoppers and the Brooklyn Cyclones play against each other. Prior to the realignment in Minor League Baseball ahead of the 2021 season, the Cyclones were part of the New York Penn League at Short Season Class A, while Greensboro has been part of the South Atlantic League since 1979. Pittsburgh has had an affiliate with Greensboro since 2019. Prior to that, the Miami Marlins were with Greensboro from 2003-2018 and the Yankees from 1990-2002. Baseball in Greensboro dates back to the early 1900s.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past 11 games -- the best home run stretch of his career. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .406 OBP and a .897 OPS, reaching in 15 of his past 17 games.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 19 total bases in his past 10 games with four doubles, one triple, and a home run.

HELP! I NEED SOMEONE: Brooklyn ranks 117 out of 120 Minor League teams with 295 runs scored and 117 out of 120 teams in batting average (.215) and home runs (44).

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted

vs. GREENSBORO: The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a match-up with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguers No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 37 home runs in the past 47 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

FUTURE IS HERE: C **Francisco Alvarez**, who is currently with Triple-A Syracuse, has been named the Mets representative at the 2022 Futures Game in Los Angeles during All-Star Week along with Triple-A INF/OF **Mark Vientos**. Alvarez, who was with the Cyclones in 2021, will participate in the game for the second consecutive year. The Mets No. 1 prospect homered in the 2021 game.

GLORIOUS JUNE...PLUS: Nick Zwack was Brooklyn’s best pitcher in June, allowing one run over 25 innings, good for a 0.36 ERA. After six innings in his past start on July 6, he’s on a stretch of one run allowed in his past 31 innings for a 0.29 ERA.

PUNCHIES: Zwack struck out 10 on July 6 against Aberdeen, becoming the first Cyclones pitcher to collect 10 strikeouts since Kyle Wilson on August 10, 2018 against the Connecticut Tigers in Coney Island.

SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS: Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw’s strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

YEAR ONE: After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

BIG EAST BEST: Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

X MARKS THE SPOT: Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.
