ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Trailing 2-1 into the seventh inning, the Cyclones rallied for five unanswered runs to steal game one from Winston-Salem 6-2. Dash LHP **Tommy Sommer** shut Brooklyn down, leaving the Clones with just one run over the first six innings, but the Cyclones woke up against the bullpen. INF **Shervyen Newton** tied the game in the seventh with an RBI single and capped the Brooklyn offense with a two-run home run in the ninth inning. OF **Stanley Consuegra** finished with three hits and OF **Alex Ramirez** tallied a single and a double. The Cyclones bullpen held the Dash scoreless for the final seven innings of the night as RHP **Trey McLoughlin**, RHP **Nolan Clenney**, and LHP **Nathan Lavender** pitched scoreless baseball.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have five games remaining in the 2022 regular season. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in first place a game and a half ahead of the New York Yankees affiliate the Hudson Valley Renegades who are playing Wilmington this week at Frawley Stadium.

SEND ME A POSTCARD: Brooklyn travels down to Winston-Salem for the first time in team history. After the realignment of the Minor Leagues, the Cyclones and Dash joined the South Atlantic League in 2021. Brooklyn hosted the Dash in August in Coney Island and heads to Truist Stadium for the first time. Brooklyn has still not matched up with league opponents Rome or Hickory since the realignment.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since August 1, INF **Jose Peroza** is hitting .342 with a .440 OBP and a .917 OPS. In the stretch, Peroza has 20 strikeouts and 20 walks. On June 29, Peroza's batting average sank down to .199 and currently sits at .259.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .356 with a .893 OPS,

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox High-A affiliate is currently in last place in the South Division in the second half. The Dash host none of the White Sox Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Brooklyn split a six-game series with Winston-Salem in Coney Island August 2-7. The Dash has played at Truist Stadium since 2010. Baseball in Winston-Salem dates back to 1905 and even the Brooklyn Dodgers had a farm team in WS in 1938.

going 26-73 with seven doubles, a home run in 17 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the rankings completely.

MENA UNO: C **Jose Mena** has hits in nine of his past 10 games with three multi-hit games. The Dominican has hit .307 since the beginning of August. This year, Mena has played in 80 games. Prior to 2022, his sixth season with the Mets, Mena has never played in more than 34 games. He has had 310 plate appearances this year, crushing his career-high of 115.

LUGO LAUNCHING: Over his past six games, 3B **William Lugo** has two doubles, two home runs, and 10 RBIs, hitting .429 (12-28). Lugo has blasted four home runs with Brooklyn and has a career-high 14 overall after 10 long balls with Low-A St. Lucie.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 499 runs in 127 games (3.9 runs/game).


THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 534 runs in 127 games (4.2 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for ninth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

PLAYOFFS: Brooklyn hosts Aberdeen Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. if the Cyclones clinch a playoff spot.

QUALITY TIME: Moreno spun a career-high seven innings last Thursday against Wilmington, shutting down the Blue Rocks in Coney Island.

BEST DOWN HERE: Moreno has a full-season best 2.85 ERA, leading all qualified Mets minor leaguers. The next-best qualified pitcher is Brooklyn RHP Dominic Hamel who has a 3.46 ERA.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as “quality starts.”

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno’s 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
