LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned a series split with an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on Sunday afternoon...Cyclones tallied 5 runs in the 2nd inning before Wilmington tied it with a 5 spot in the 4th...**3B William Lugo's** go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the 5th gave Brooklyn the lead for good...All 9 batters in the Cyclones' lineup registered at least 1 hit...**CF Rhylan Thomas**, **2B D'Andre Smith**, and **DH Mateo Gil** all tallied multi-hit games...**Gil**, **RF Stanley Consuegra**, and **SS Junior Tilen** each posted multiple RBI...**3B Murphy Stehly** composed a team-high 2 hits for Wilmington...**C Geraldí Díaz** drove in 5, adding a grand slam in the 4th...The Cyclones used a season-high 9 pitchers en route to the win.

TURN IT UP TO ELEVEN: The Cyclones scored a season-high 11 runs during Thursday evening and Sunday afternoon's wins vs. Wilmington...It marked the second and third times this season Brooklyn had registered double digits in runs scored with the previous high watermark coming in a 10-6 win at Jersey Shore on June 4...The 11-run outbursts were the most for the 'Clones since they accrued 18 runs in an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Additionally, it is the most Brooklyn had scored at Maimonides Park since a 14-0 beatdown of Hudson Valley on May 19, 2021.

TOP OF THE CYCLONE: Brooklyn has won 15-of-22 (.682) and 21-of-31 (.677) going into Tuesday's series opener...The Cyclones earned a series split with Wilmington, snapping a streak of winning 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn has not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11, going 5-0-2 in 7 sets...The Cyclones are 20-10 in the second half and hold a 2.5-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Aberdeen (17-12)...Brooklyn is a half-game ahead of Hickory (19-10) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

CHANGE UP: The Cyclones used a season-high 9 different pitchers en route to their 11-7 win on Sunday afternoon vs. Wilmington...That is the most arms used by Brooklyn in a game of any length since moving to the full-season level before 2021...**RHP Benito García** tossed a scoreless inning in a spot start...**RHP Joshua Cornielly** (2.0 IP), **RHP Manny Rodríguez** (0.2), **RHP Dylan Hall** (0.1), **RHP Jace Beck** (1.0), **RHP Brendan Hardy** (1.0), **RHP Luis Montas** (1.0), **LHP Eli Ankeney** (1.0), and **RHP Paul Gervase** (1.0) all emerged in relief...Before Sunday, the most arms the 'Clones had used in a single game was 7...That last occurred on Tuesday, July 25 vs. Wilmington.

NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn added 4 players from Single-A St. Lucie prior to Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore...**RHP Jawilme Ramírez**, **RHP Bailey Reid**, **INF Jacob Reimer**, and **INF Jett Williams** all joined the 'Clones from the Florida State League...Williams was ranked as the Mets' No. 3 prospect at midseason by *Baseball America* and Reimer comes in at No. 10...Williams was the No. 14 pick in the first round of last summer's MLB draft out of high school...In 79 games, the 19-year-old slashed .249/.422/.410 with a .832 OPS, 6 home runs, 35 RBI, and 32 stolen bases...Williams was the FSL leader in on-base percentage (.422) at the time of his promotion, also ranking 3rd in walks (69), 4th in stolen bases (32), tied for 5th in triples (6), and 7th in OPS (.832)...Reimer slashed .280/.412/.392 with a .804 OPS, 6 home runs, and 37 RBI in 75 games with St. Lucie...The 19-year-old left the circuit ranked 4th in on-base percentage (.412) and 7th in batting average (.280)...Ramírez made 18 appearances (6 starts) with St. Lucie, composing a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP) and 61 strikeouts...Reid signed with the Mets in June after being released by the Cubs, punching out 13 in 6.1 innings over 8 relief outings in the FSL.

BINGO BOUND: On Monday, the Cyclones sent a pair of players up to Double-A Binghamton: **INF Mateo Gil** and **RHP Blade Tidwell**...After joining Brooklyn from Binghamton at the start of May, Gil appeared in 62 games, tallying a .208/.282/.443 slash line with a .726 OPS, adding 10 home runs and 31 RBI...Since May 18 at Hudson Valley, the 23-year-old's numbers jumped to .230/.309/.477 with a .786 OPS and 109 wRC+...Tidwell departs with Brooklyn's single-season strikeout record (112) and is 4th all-time in franchise history in that department...Tidwell earned the win in 6 of his final 7 outings with Brooklyn winning all 7 games...He permitted just 7 runs on 27 hits over 43.0 innings...He walked only 13 (7.8 BB%) and struck out 52 (31.3 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...That came after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his final 12 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell went 8-0 with a 1.56 ERA (1 ER in 63.1 IP) and just 37 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native walked 33 and struck out 85 (33.2 K%)...Tidwell held opponents to a meager .167 batting average (.37-.221) against him...In that time, Tidwell leads all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.56) and batting average against (.167) (min. 60.0 IP)...He was also tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League and tied for 5th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (85)...At the time of his departure, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads the SAL in batting average against (.190), was 2nd in wins (8), 3rd in strikeouts (112) and ERA (3.09), and 7th in WHIP (1.24).

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: **RHP Cameron Foster** took the loss but punched out a career-high 12 on Saturday evening vs. Wilmington...The 12 punchouts are the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2023...Foster is the 3rd different Brooklyn arm to strike out 10+ batters in a single game this year...**RHP Tyler Stuart** whiffed 11 on June 22, while **RHP Blade Tidwell** has accomplished the feat 4 times...The Houston native is the first Cyclone pitcher to strikeout 12-plus batters in a single contest since **RHP Marcos Molina** collected 12 strikeouts on August 15, 2014, in a 7-0 win at Vermont...Foster is the first to accomplish the feat at home since **RHP Collin McHugh** collected 12 K's vs. Jamestown on August 8, 2009...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-1 record with a 3.32 ERA (14 ER in 38.0 IP) with 11 walks and 46 strikeouts over 8 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 6.8% from his overall numbers (29.7% from 22.9%) and his walk rate is down 3.0% (7.0% from 10.0%).

I GOT YOUR SIX: **OF Alex Ramírez** became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed **3B Marcos Cabrera** of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...**OF Sammy Sosa** (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and **OF Max Carey** (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL).

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, **OF Alex Ramírez** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (36) and 3rd in pitches-per-plate appearance (3.995) (min. 200 PA)...Since his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old has accrued multi-hit games in 5 of his last 8 outings...In that span, Alex is slashing .460/.462/.649 with a 1.110 OPS...Ramírez is 17-for-37 at the plate (.459) with 7 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 3 stolen bases...Ramírez has 3 more hits (17) than any other player in the SAL during that span...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (77) and is 14 behind **INF José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark and 3 behind **INF Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd...He tied with Peroza for 1st in doubles (34), 2nd in total bases (214), 3rd in hits (145), and tied for 3rd in runs scored (76).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.97 ERA (185 ER in 560.0 IP) over their last 65 games, holding a 37-27 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.22) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts — which tied for 2nd-most in MiLB — in that span and hold a

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 3 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: **INF Hao-Yu Lee** (8), **OF Gabriel Rincón Jr.** (10), **C Caleb Ricketts** (20)...Ricketts is currently on the team's 7-day injured list...Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark for the third and final time and the first time since the BlueClaws took 5-of-8 from the Cyclones from May 30-June 4...The Cyclones are 9-11 (.450) against the BlueClaws in the first 20 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2021, Brooklyn is 44-33 all-time against Jersey Shore (.571).

strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 11.4%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.623), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.91) and batting average against (.210) in that period...**RHPs Blade Tidwell** (1.56), **Tyler Stuart** (1.99), and **RHP Christian Scott** (2.10) hold the 1st, 2nd, and 4th best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 60.0 IP).

THE RHY-T STUFF: **OF Rhylan Thomas** had his 11-game hitting streak since July 8 snapped on Saturday, but added 2 more hits on Sunday...In 16 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is slashing .386/.429/.439 with a .867 OPS at the dish with a 141 wRC+...Thomas has added 8 runs scored, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 walks to only 3 strikeouts...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 63 fewer plate appearances (139 to 76)...Among players with 65 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.367).

ACE GERVASE: **RHP Paul Gervase** has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 27 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 4th in ERA (1.51) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 40.0 IP)...Fellow 2023 Cyclone and current Double-A Binghamton **LHP Daniel Juárez** (1.52) is 5th in MiLB...The 2022 12th-round pick is 6th in MiLB in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.47) and 9th in opposing batting average (.153)...Among SAL relievers with at least 40.0 IP, the Fuquay-Varina, N.C. native leads the circuit in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.47), is 2nd in hits allowed (22) and opposing OPS (.529), and tied for 4th in saves (6)...Gervase leads all Mets farmhands in strikeout rate at 36.2% (min. 40.0 IP).

BULLPEN BOOM: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn is tied for the best bullpen ERA (3.42) in the entire South Atlantic League with Hudson Valley and hold the 6th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (.313) leads MiLB.

NINE TIMES! Brooklyn posted their best offensive inning of the season in the bottom of the 2nd on Thursday night vs. Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 9 runs on 6 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...8 of the 9 hitters in Brooklyn's lineup reached base safely in the 2nd inning...Brooklyn's previous season high came when they scored 6 times in the top of the 2nd on June 4 at Jersey Shore...The 9-run frame was the most by the Cyclones in a single frame since they scratched across 10 tallies in the top of the 6th on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green...Brooklyn went on to win that contest, 20-6...The 9-run inning was the largest for the Cyclones at home since an 8-tally bottom of the 7th on August 12, 2016, vs. West Virginia...Brooklyn won that affair, 14-7.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on July 22 at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 8 appearances (7 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-4 record, but a 3.22 ERA (13 ER in 36.1 IP), 14 walks (9.3 BB%), and 51 strikeouts (34.0 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 4 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native is 0-3, yet holds a 1.99 ERA (5 ER in 22.2 IP) with 7 walks (7.6 BB%) and 32 strikeouts (34.8 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 8th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Wilmington on Wednesday...5 different pitchers combined on the 3-hit shutout...**RHPs Blade Tidwell** (5.0 IP), **Jace Beck** (1.0), **Brendan Hardy** (1.0), **Dylan Hall** (1.0), and **LHP Eli Ankeney** (1.0)...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 3-0 victory vs. Greensboro on July 15...Brooklyn has surpassed their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 8 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.

DE RECORD SETTER: **OF Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base last Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks **INF Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Mariners farmhand **OF Jonatan Clásé** (111), D'Backs prospect **OF Wilder Pardo** (110), Aberdeen **OF Luis Valdez** (110), Red Sox prospect **INF David Hamilton** (108), Marlins farmhand **INF Nasim Núñez** (106), and Cardinals prospect **OF Mike Antico** (105) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone **IF/OF Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 47.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 19th come-from-behind victory with a 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on Thursday...The Cyclones matched their largest comeback of the year on July 23 at Hudson Valley, erasing a 4-run, 4-0 deficit entering the 4th inning...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4 vs. Wilmington and on Opening Day, April 7, vs. Jersey Shore...July 21 marked the 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley...It was also Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...9 members of the 2023 squad are featured...**Kevin Parada** (No. 2), **INF Jett Williams** (3), **OF Alex Ramírez** (5), **RHP Blade Tidwell** (7), **RHP Christian Scott** (9), **INF Jacob Reimer** (10), **RHP Raimon Gómez** (16), **RHP Tyler Stuart** (17), and **RHP Jordany Ventura** (24)...Former Cyclones listed include: **INF Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), **RHP Mike Vasil** (4), **OF Matt Rudick** (13), **RHP Dominic Hamel** (14), **RHP Junior Santos** (20), **RHP José Butto** (25), **RHP Luis Moreno** (26), and **OF Rowdy Jordan** (27)...In all, 17-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in a start last Wednesday afternoon at Hudson Valley...Surrendered 2 runs on 1 hit over a season-high 4.2 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 5...Permitted a 2-run home run to 1B **Rafael Flores** in the bottom of the 1st...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with the bases empty and 2 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn behind 2-1...Cyclones rallied to take the lead, but the Renegades scored 3 in the bottom of the 8th to win, 6-4.

THE ROCO SHOW: The right-hander struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley and has been on a tear since...Over his last 6 appearances (2 start), Colina holds a 2-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER in 19.0 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 12 hits and walked 5 with 22 strikeouts...Colina's strikeout rate is up 3.4 percent (30.6 K%) and walk rate is down 1.6 percent (6.9 BB%) during the time span.

ALWAYS MOVING: Colina has already pitched at 3 separate levels in 2023...The 22-year-old was assigned to Single-A St. Lucie to start the season...After making 1 appearance, Colina was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on April 16...Earned the win in his lone outing for the Rumble Ponies on April 18...He was transferred to Brooklyn on April 24.

2022: Split the season between St. Lucie and the Florida Complex League...Assigned to St. Lucie on May 2...Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K's in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).

STARTING TIME: Colina expects to make his 4th start of the 2023 season after pitching in relief during his initial 10 of his first 11 appearances...Last season, the 22-year-old started in 8 of his 14 outings...In a starting role in 2022, Colina held a 1-3 record with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) in 8 starts...He held a walk rate of 7.3% and a strikeout rate of 28.7%...In 4 relief appearances, the Punto Fijo, VZ native was 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP)...Colina's walk rate was 12.7% and strikeout rate hovered at 28.2%.
