**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Senators, 9-0. **Jack Choate** started and allowed two runs over five innings. It was Richmond's second straight game being shut out, the 13th time in franchise history the Flying Squirrels have been blanked in back-to-back games. It was the first time Richmond has been shutout in consecutive games since August 3-4, 2023 at Altoona.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams played in Harrisburg's first home series at FNB Field from April 9-13, with Richmond taking two-of-six in the series. The Flying Squirrels have been outscored 28-0 in the series. They are trying to avoid being shut out in three straight games for the third time in franchise history. They were blanked in three straight games from June 25-27, 2015, with the first two against the Trenton Thunder and the third at New Britain. They were also shut out three times in four games during that stretch. The last time the Flying Squirrels were shut out in three straight games was August 25-27, 2018, with the first two at Altoona, including the second game of a doubleheader to start the streak, and the opener of a series against

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,894 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7.290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** split last week's series against the Patriots, winning three straight games from Thursday through Sunday for their longest win streak of the season. Their 8-21 start is the worst in franchise history. The 2015 Flying Squirrels started 3-2 before losing a franchise-record 15 consecutive games, falling to 3-17. They snapped the losing slide with a six-game win streak and finished the year 72-68, one game out of a postseason spot.

THE SENATORS have won seven-of-their-last-nine games, including taking four-of-six last week at Reading. Harrisburg lost four straight games to open the season but have gone 15-10 since. The Senators lead the Eastern League in hits (241) and total bases (402) and rank tied for second in homers (29). Harrisburg's roster includes three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9) and 1B/3B Yohandy Morales (No. 2). Harrisburg's roster also featured three players included in MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and Morales (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Seth Lonsway makes his sixth start of the season and the third of his career against the Senators. He last pitched last Friday against the Patriots and allowed three runs over three innings in a no-decision. He made his season debut on April 8 in Harrisburg and threw five scoreless innings, striking out seven. Lonsway also threw 6.1 scoreless innings against the Senators on July 10, 2024. He has combined for 11.1 scoreless innings against the Senators in his career. His 2.08 career ERA with Richmond is the third-lowest (min. 50 IP) in franchise history. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. For more on Lonsway, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Kyle Luckham makes his sixth Double-A start of the season and his second this year against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Friday at Reading and threw seven scoreless innings. Including one start with Triple-A Rochester, Luckham has thrown three consecutive starts without allowing a run dating back to April 20, spanning 18 innings. This year marks Luckham's third overall with the Senators. He first pitched for Harrisburg for one start in 2023. Last year, he worked 23 games (21 starts), going 5-8 with a 4.47 ERA. Luckham was promoted to Triple-A Rochester last July for four starts before returning to Double-A. Luckham has made five previous starts against Richmond in his career, four of them last season, and has gone 0-2 with a 5.60 ERA (17 ER/27.1 IP). Luckham was selected in the 15th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Arizona State University.

**DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND:** The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 18 stolen base attempts this season, which is first among all 30 Double-A teams. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 10 runners caught stealing, which is also tied for first the EL. Morgan is fourth in the EL with eight.

**THE BRYCE IS RIGHT:** Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster last Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On Thursday, he tied his Double-A high with three hits. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .316 (12-for-38) in his last nine games.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell opened the season batting .189 (14-for-74) in his first 20 games through April 26. In his last eight games dating back to April 29, Howell is batting .333 (11-for-33) with three homers, two doubles, five RBIs, four walks and six runs scored. After hitting three homers in his first 136 Double-A games, he homered three times over a five-game span from last Wednesday through Sunday. On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week for the first time. Last year, Howell was named Richmond's Player of the Year and led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7) and leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), OBP (.347), SLG (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), runs (64) and stolen bases (15).

**GO, DIEGO, GO: Diego Velasquez** had his league-leading 13-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday afternoon. In those 13 games from April 18-May 2, Velasquez hit .392 (20-for-51) with a homer, four doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. In his 69 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .314 (79-for-252). His 13-game hit streak was the longest since a 13-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in 2022.

CLOSING THE DOOR: On Thursday, Tyler Myrick closed the 14th save of his Flying Squirrels career, tying ninth place on the franchise's all-time list with Brett Bochy (2012) and Melvin Adon (2019, 2022). In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Myrick has converted 82.4 percent of his save attempts, which is tied for fifth-highest in franchise history (min. 15 attempts). In 2023 between Richmond and High-A Eugene, Myrick went 15-for-15 in save attempts, the only pitcher in MiLB with a perfect mark and at least 12 tries.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is first in hits (33) and eighth in batting average (.314). Jairo Pomares is tied for fifth in homers (5). Jack Choate is tied for sixth in strikeouts (34).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 212 wins in his career, which is four away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

AWARDS SWEEP: On Monday, Carter Howell was named Eastern League Player of the Week after homered three times against Somerset and Joe Whitman was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after throwing six perfect innings on Saturday with 10 strikeouts. It marked the fifth time in franchise history the team has swept the league's weekly awards, joining Daniel Mayora and Justin Fitzgerald (July 9-16, 2012), Steven Duggar and Andrew Suarez (July 18-24, 2016), Brett Auerbach and Wil Jensen (August 1-7, 2022) and Grant McCray and John Michael Bertrand (May 20-26, 2024).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

#### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND **BASEBALL HISTORY**

**1961:** The Richmond Virginians beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 1-0, at Parker Field. Bill Bethel acuse Chiefs, 1-0, at Parker Field. Bill Bethel started and threw a three-hit shutout. He took a no-hit bid into the sixth inning. Richmond's lone run scored with help from an error in the second inning to set up an RBI single by Richie Windle. 1980: The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 4-3, at Parker Field. Butch Edge, who had been released by Toronto during spring training, threw a complete game for Richmond against his old organization and allowed three runs. which all scored on a hoallowed three runs, which all scored on a homer by Doug Ault in the third. Richmond rallied to tie the score in the fourth. Terry Harper hit a single, a run scored on a wild pitch and Harry Saferight tied the game with a single. In the sixth, Saferight gave the R-Braves the lead for good with a single. 1983: The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 5-3, in 10 innings at Parker Field. Down 3-0 heading into the seventh, Larry Whisenton homered to break the shutout. In the eighth, a run scored on an error and Paul Runge tied the game with a solo homer. In the bottom of the 10th, Gerald Perr hit a walk-off, two-run homer to win the game. 2017: The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 3-1. Brandon Crawford returned to Richmond on a rehab as¬signment and went 1-for-3 with a dou-ble. Chris Shaw had a pair of RBI hits. Ali Castillo broke a 1-1 tie in the eighth.
