**D-BACKS UNVEIL CITY CONNECT:** The Arizona Diamondbacks unveiled their new Nike City Connect Serpientes uniforms, a cutting-edge redesign representing the iconic Diamondbacks jerseys over the years, focusing on vibrant colors and reimagining traditional patterning to create something unmistakably Arizona...the new uniforms will be debuted this Friday, May 9 and Sat., May 10 vs. Dodgers during Mexican Heritage Weekend...following this weekend, the team will wear the jerseys every Friday home game.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 11-9 @ Phillies yesterday in 10 innings after pounding out a season-high-tying 11 runs on 12 hits...Arizona is now 8-3 in series finales.

- Eduardo Rodriguez recorded 10 strikeouts over 5.1 frames (ND; 3 ER, 5 H, 4 BB), marking his second double-digit strikeout game...is 1 of just 5 NL pitchers with 2 double-digit strikeout bids.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** (4-for-5, 2 2B, 3 RBI, BB) recorded his first career 4-hit game and reached base 5 times in a game for the first time.
- **Corbin Carroll** went 2-for-6 with 3 RBI, marking his team-leading 13th multi-hit effort.
- Jose Herrera went 2-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI.
- Jalen Beeks got his first save as a D-back (16th career) and first since Sept. 11, 2024 with the Pirates.

WITHOUT THE LONG BALL: Sunday's 11-run output marked the fourth time since 2023 where Arizona scored 10+ runs without a homer (last: Sept. 15, 2024 vs. MIL).

• The D-backs' 17-7 record when scoring 4+ runs is tied for the third best record in the NL (also: Dodgers), behind the Cubs (19-4) and Giants (18-5).

FACING THE RIGHTIES: Against righty starting pitchers, the D-backs' own the best SLG (.467) in the Majors and rank among top teams in extra-base hits (2nd, 95), OPS (3rd, .798), homers (3rd, 39) and RBI (5th, 128).

**SLUG IT OUT:** Among NL teams, the D-backs rank second in extra-base hits (120), third in homers (43), third in SLG (.431) and third in OPS (.762).

**STARTER RHYHTM:** D-backs starting pitchers have allowed 3 or fewer earned runs in 10 of their last 13 starts (5 quality) and yielded 2 walks or fewer in 9 of those.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** The D-backs' 20 straight games with 2+ extra-base hits is the longest streak of its kind this season...marks their longest team streak since 23 straight games from July 22-Aug. 16, 2024.

• The D-backs' 26 total occurrences of 3+ extra-base hits in a game are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (23) and Mets (23).

**KEEPING A CLOSE EYE:** The D-backs' 1.93 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks best in the Majors, ahead of the Mariners (1.96) and Mets (2.00), while their 10.3 walk pct. is second, behind the Mariners (11.0).

• Arizona's 137 walks thru their first 34 games of a season rank third in franchise history, behind the 2000 (147) and 2005 (141) clubs.

**PERDOMO'S PERFORMANCE:** Geraldo Perdomo became the first D-back ever to record 4 hits, 3 RBI and 2 stolen bases in a game yesterday @ Phillies.

• At 25 years and 194 days, is the youngest of 5 D-backs to ever reach base 5 times and steal 2+ bases in a game, ahead of Jean Segura/2016 (26-155), Orlando Hudson/2007 (29-266), Gregor Blanco/2017 (33-281) and Craig Counsell/2005 (34-351).

**AMONG SHORTSTOPS: Geraldo Perdomo** ranks among MLB shortstops in OPS (1st, .875), walks (1st, 24), RBI (1st, 29), sacrifice flies (1st, 5), OBP (2nd, .400), SLG (2nd, .475), stolen bases (T-2nd, 9), homers (T-3rd, 5) and extra-base hits (T-4th, 12).

• His 6 games this season with 1+ hits, 1+ walks and 1+ RBI are most among shortstops, ahead of Dansby Swanson/CHC (5).

**SEEING IT WELL:** Geraldo Perdomo's 636 pitches seen are second most among MLB shortstops, behind Francisco Lindor/NYM (637).

**KETEL KEEPING PACE:** Ketel Marte owns the fifth longest active on-base streak (15 G) in the NL dating back to Sept. 24, 2024...has reached base 25 times (14 H, 10 BB, HBP) and owns a .397 OBP with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 3 RBI in that span.

**LATE ACTION:** The D-backs' 71 runs scored in the seventh inning or later (excl. extra-innings) lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (62) and Mets (61).

• From the seventh to ninth inning, the D-backs also tied for first in walks (49), and are second in SLG (.459), OPS (.807) and OBP (347).

LAWLAR PLAYER OF THE MONTH: D-backs' top prospect (MLB No. 9), Jordan Lawlar, today was named Pacific Coast League Player of the Month for April...hit .408 (42-for-103)/1.235 OPS with 13 doubles, 2 triples, 6 homers, 30 RBI and 10 stolen bases over 25 games to earn his first PCL honor.

• Will make his fifth home start in back-to-back bids
against the Metswon his last start @ Mets on May 1
after striking out 8 in 6.0 innings.
